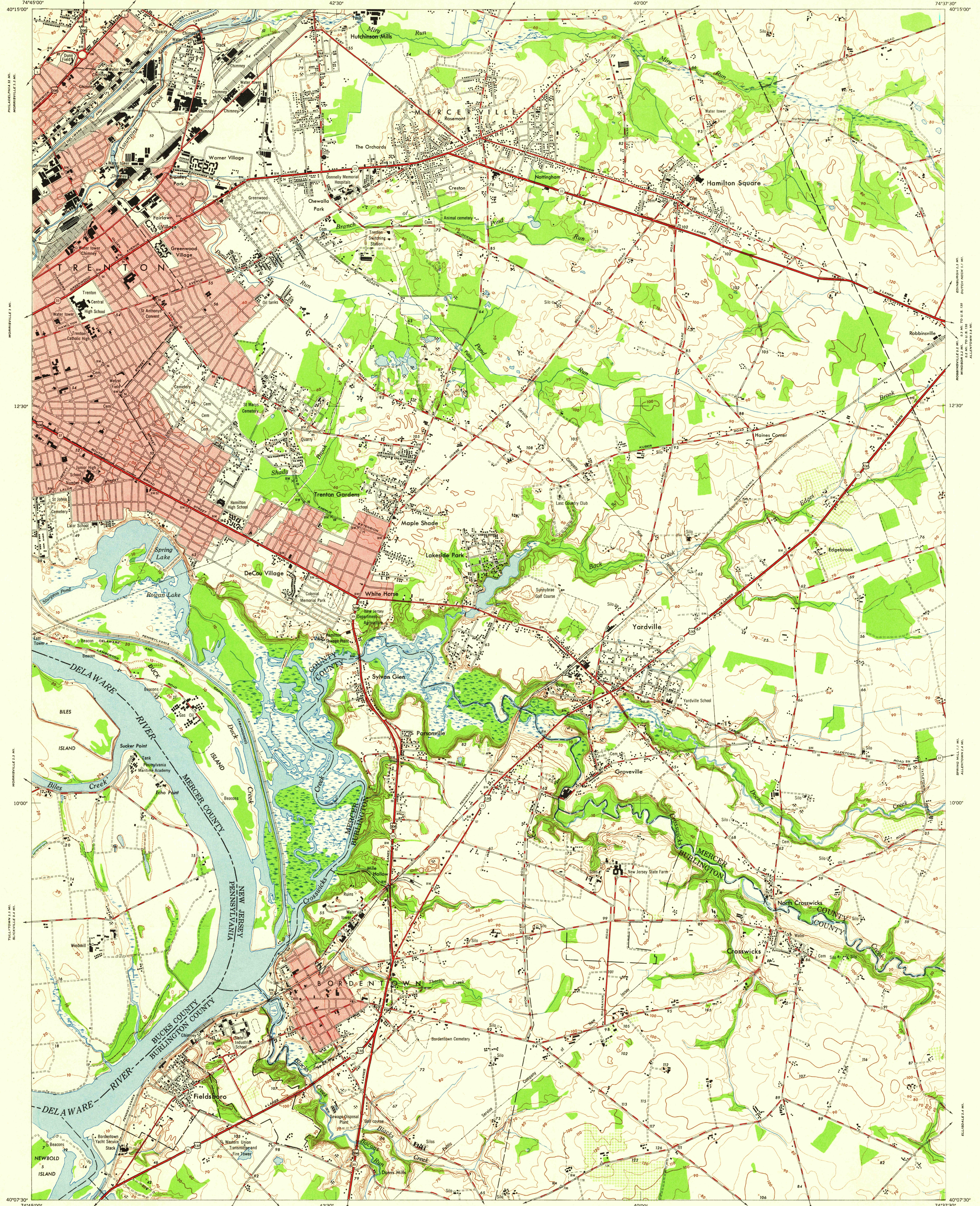




AMS 3, 1948

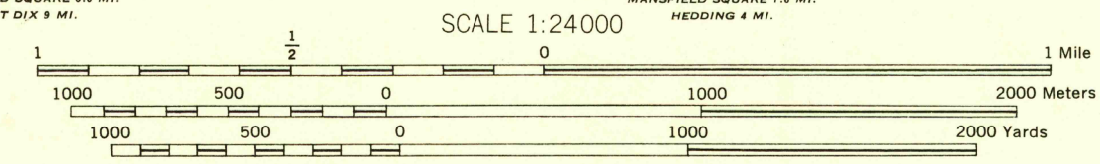

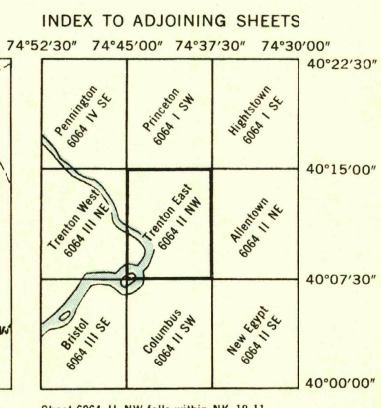
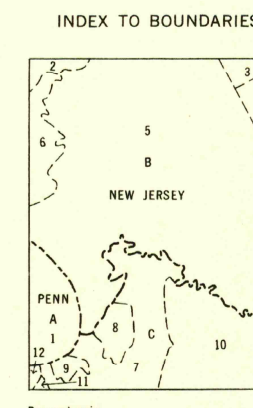
