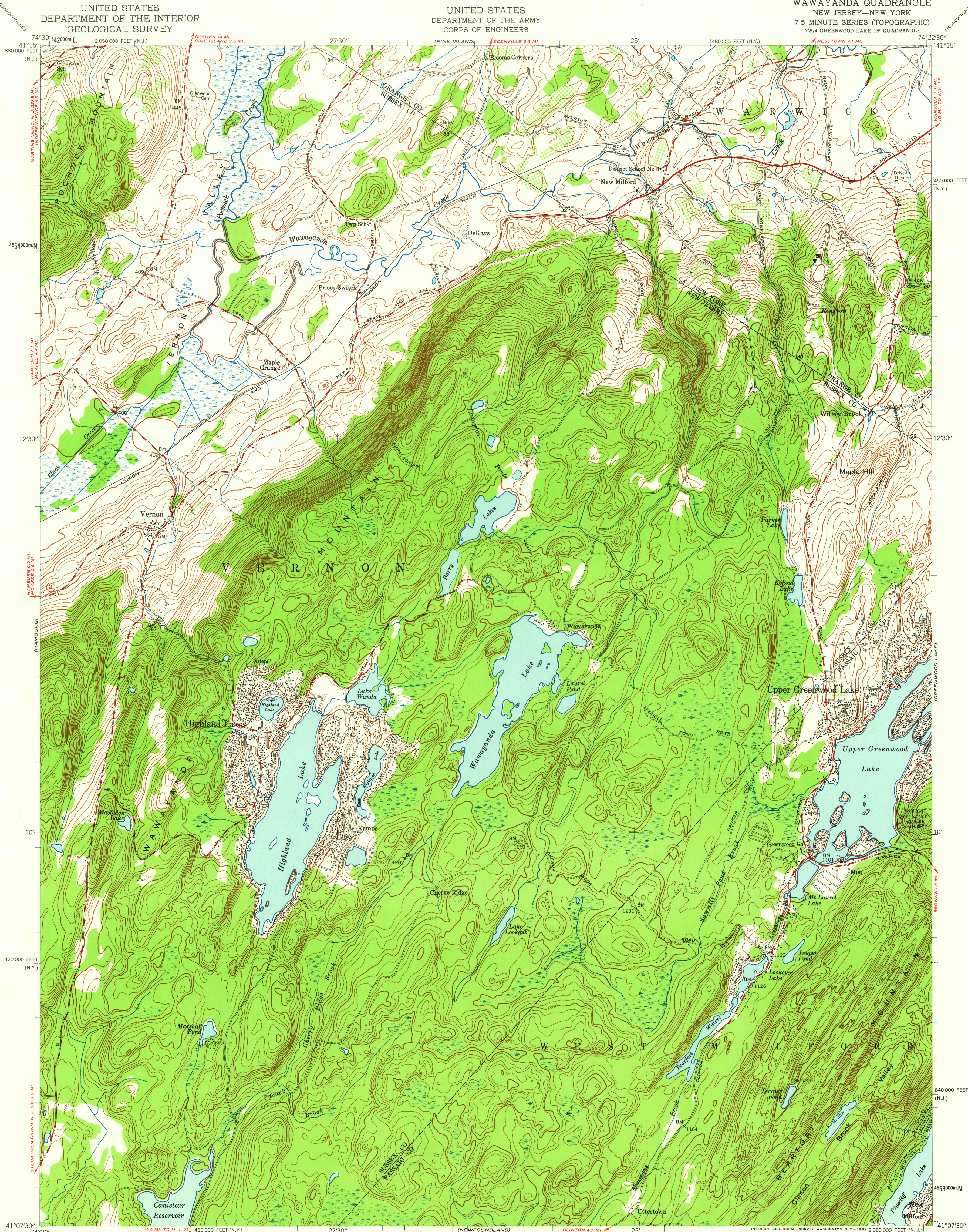

NW/4 GREENWOOD LAKE 15' QUADRANGLE



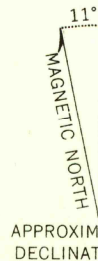

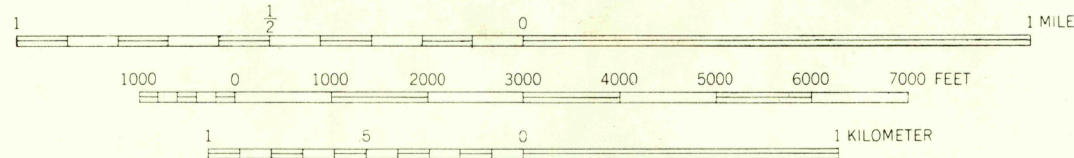
