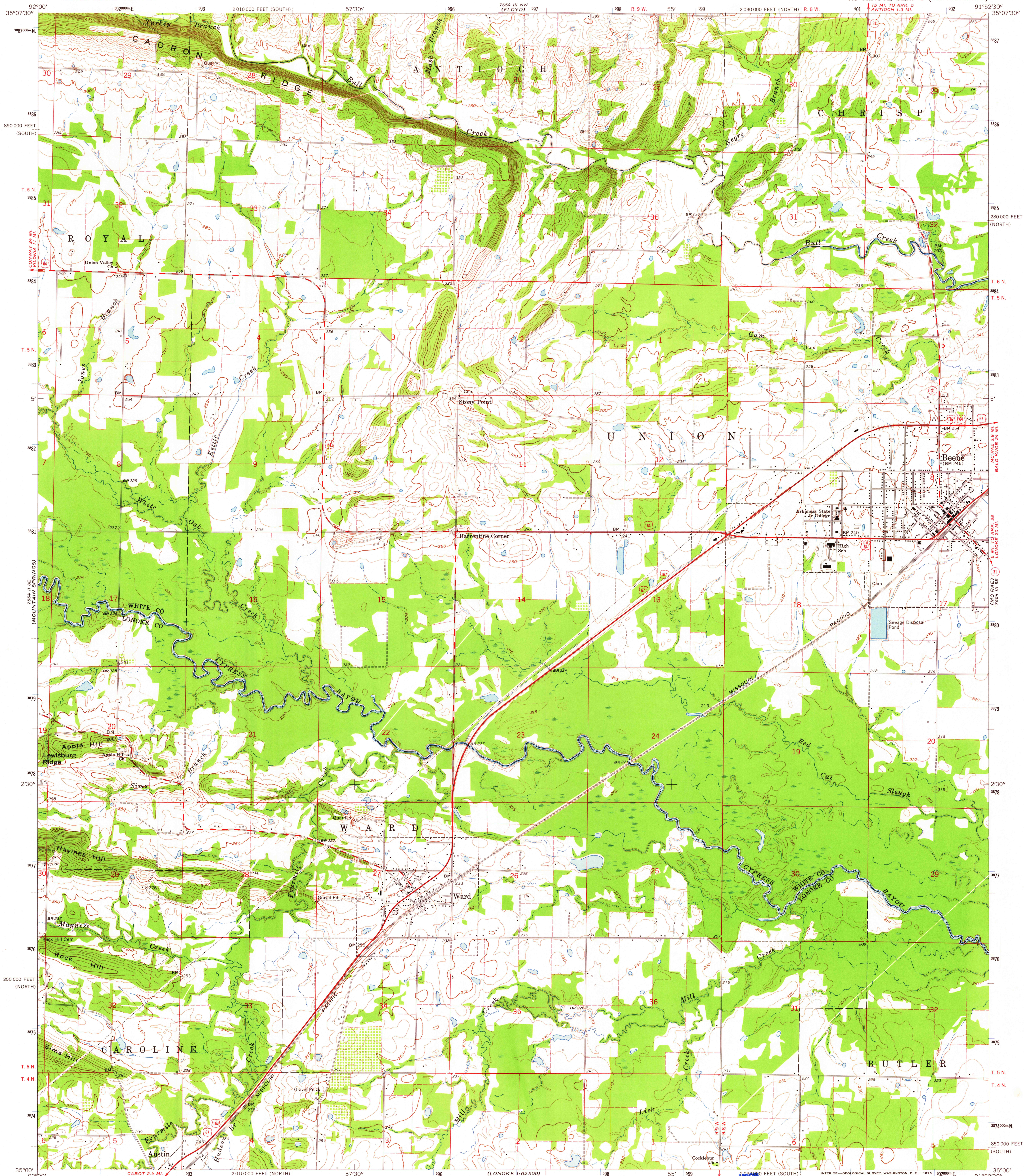

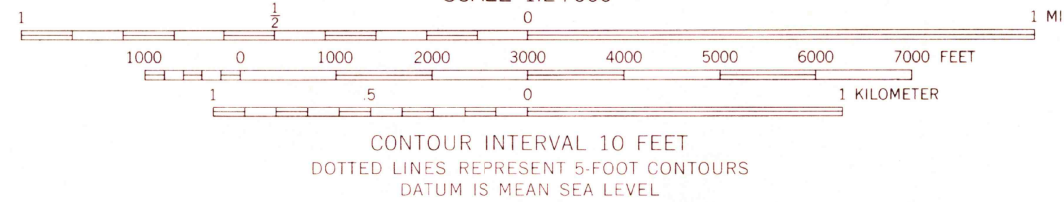
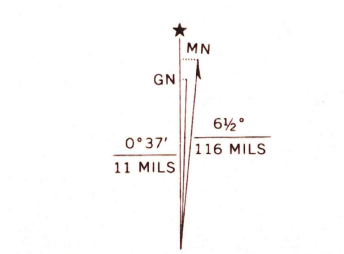
10,000-foot grids based on Arkansas coordinate system, north and south zones
