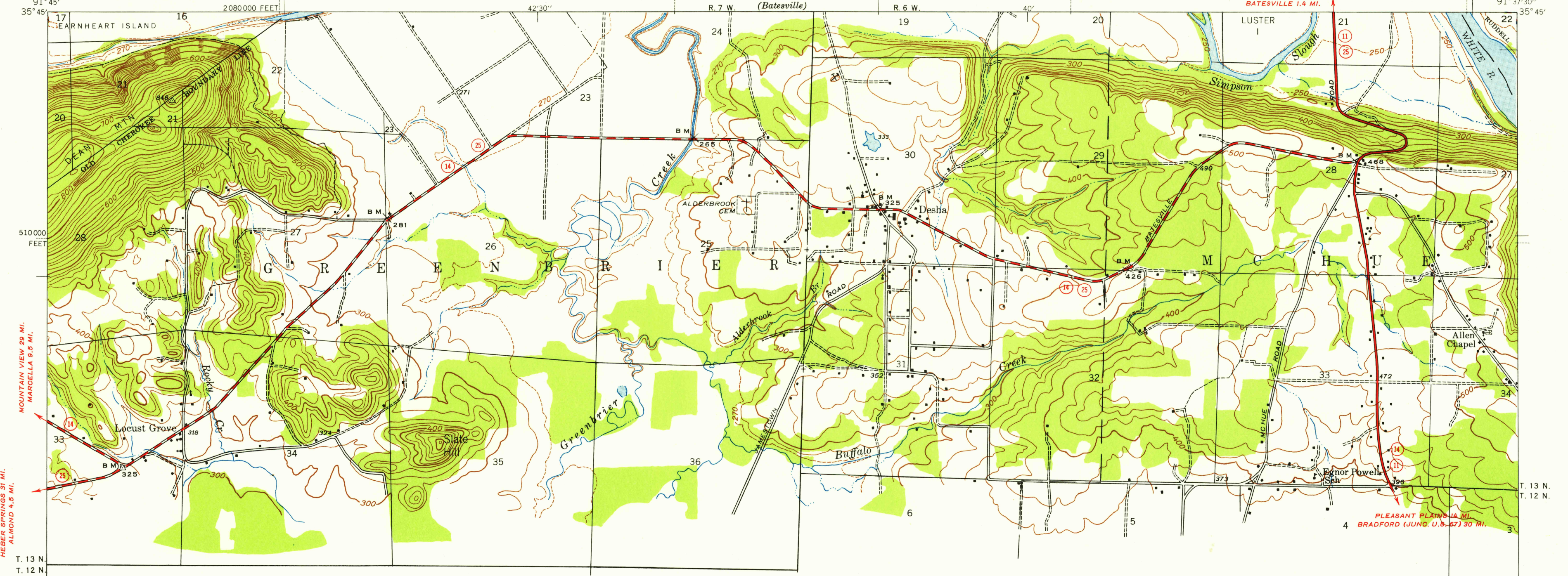




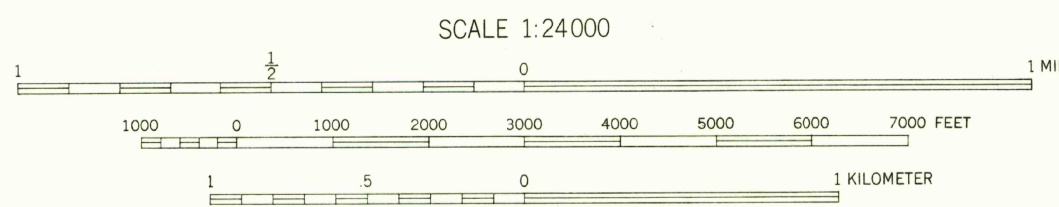
THIS AREA IS SHOWN ON THE MAP OF BATESVILLE 30 MINUTE
