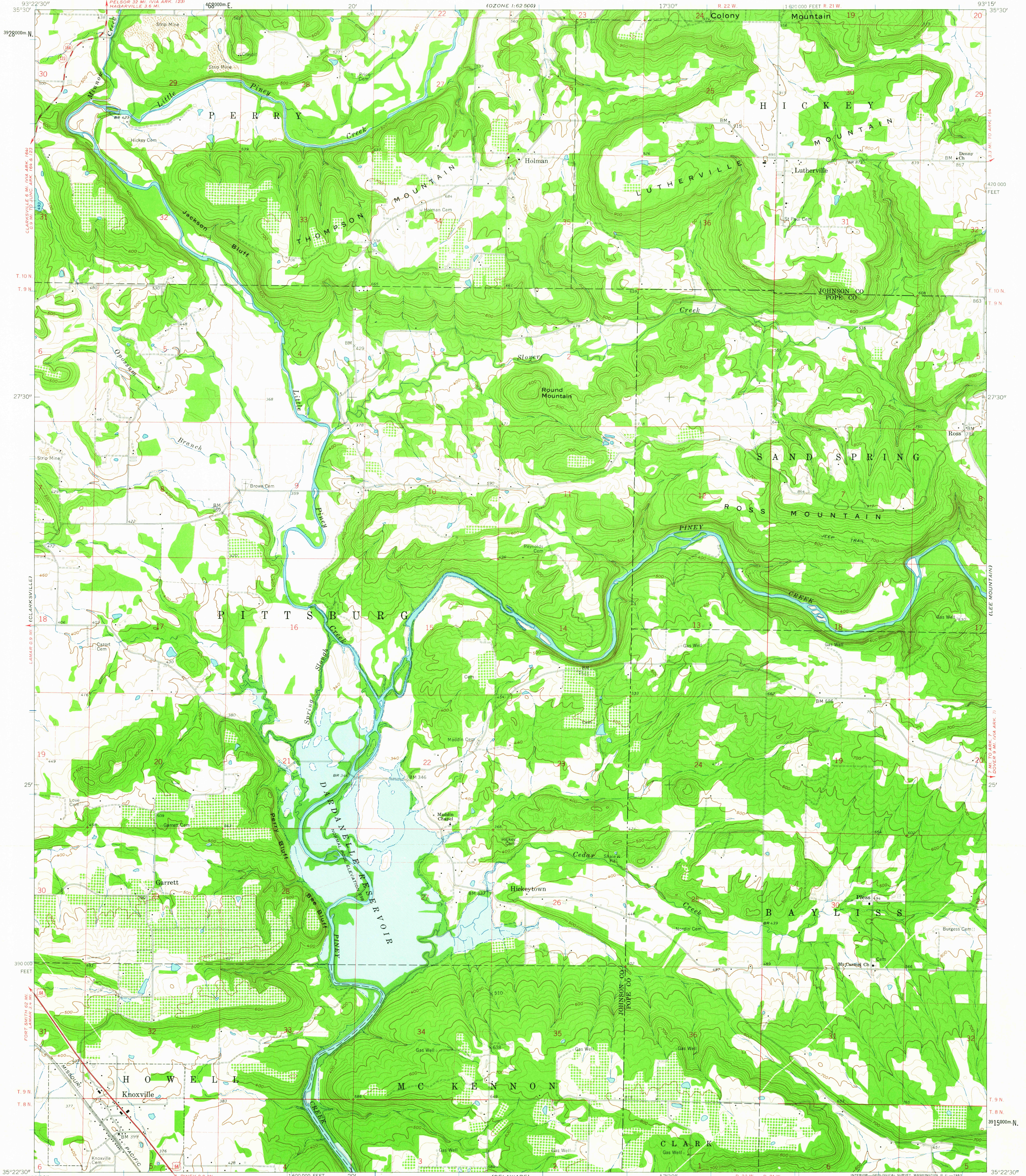

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,

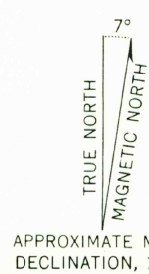

Blue hatching indicates area to be submerged

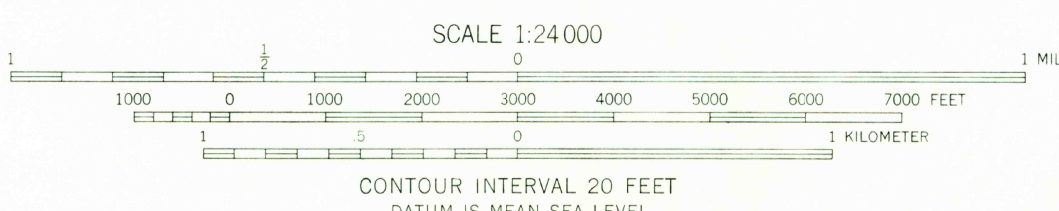
