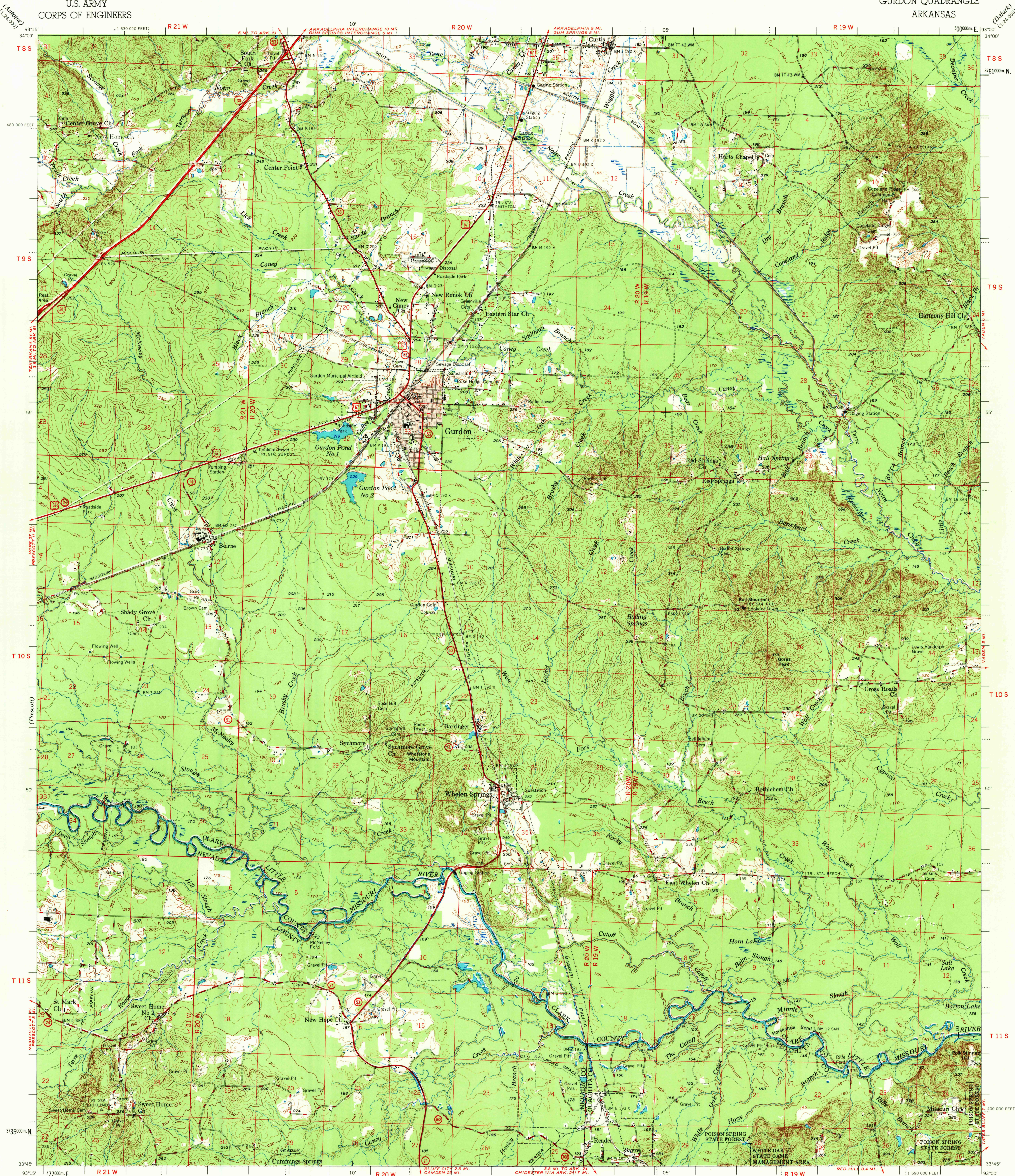




Mapped, edited and published under the direction of the President, Mississippi River Commission, by the U.S. Army Engineer District, Vicksburg, Corps of Engineers.

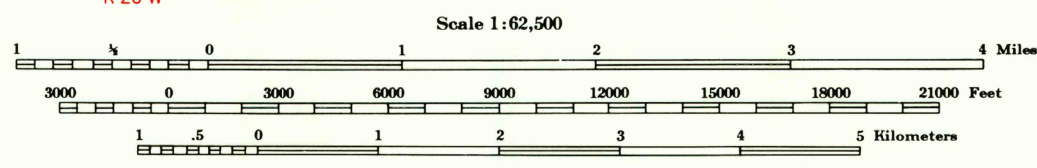

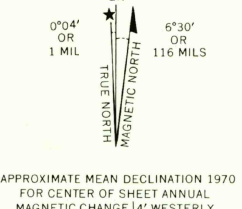
