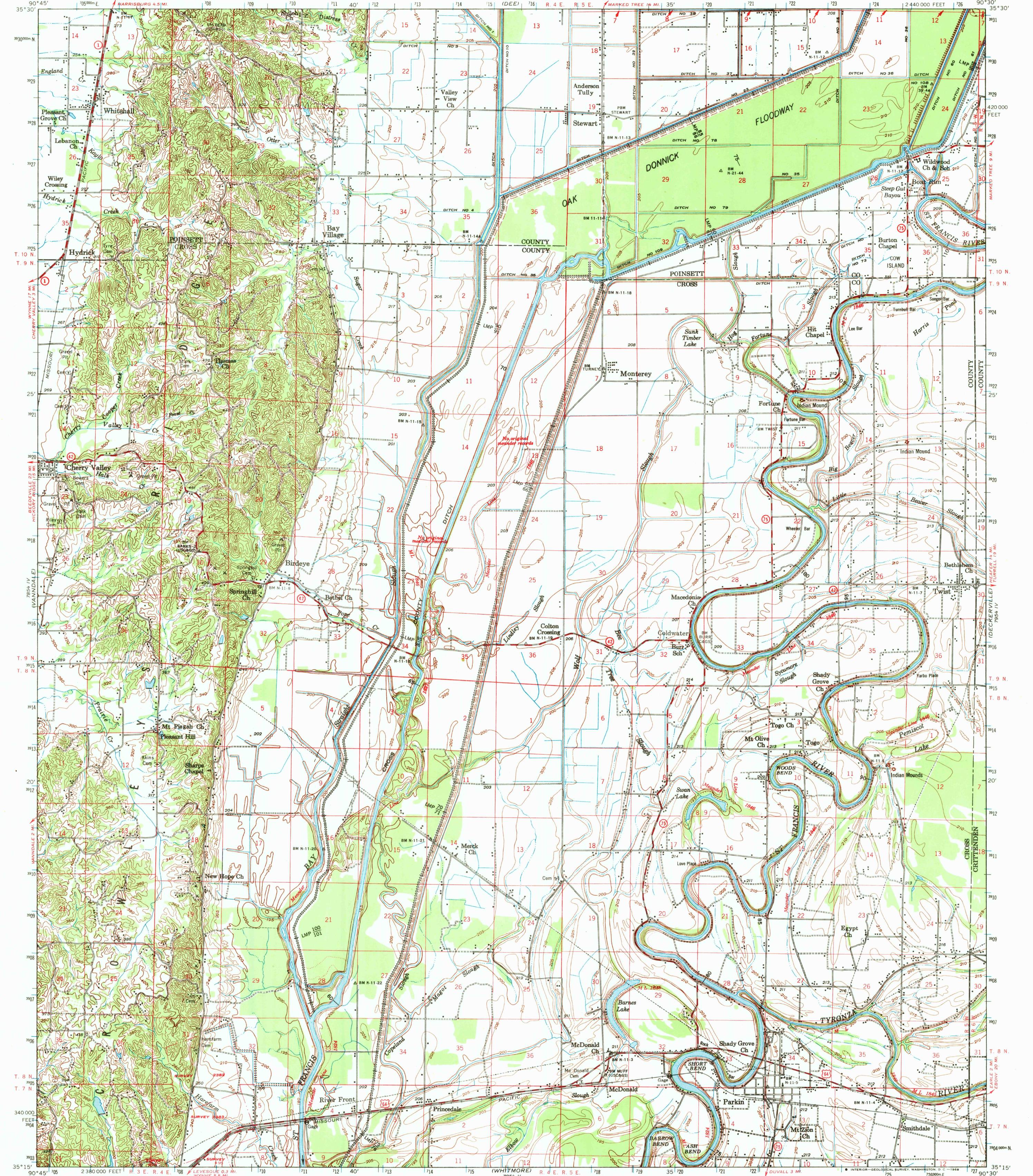

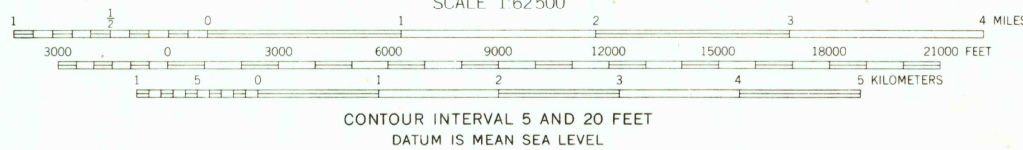
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum

zone 15, shown in blue

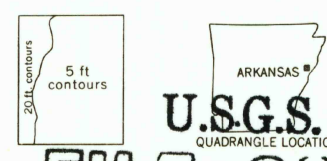
No distinction is made between dwellings, barns, commercial,
