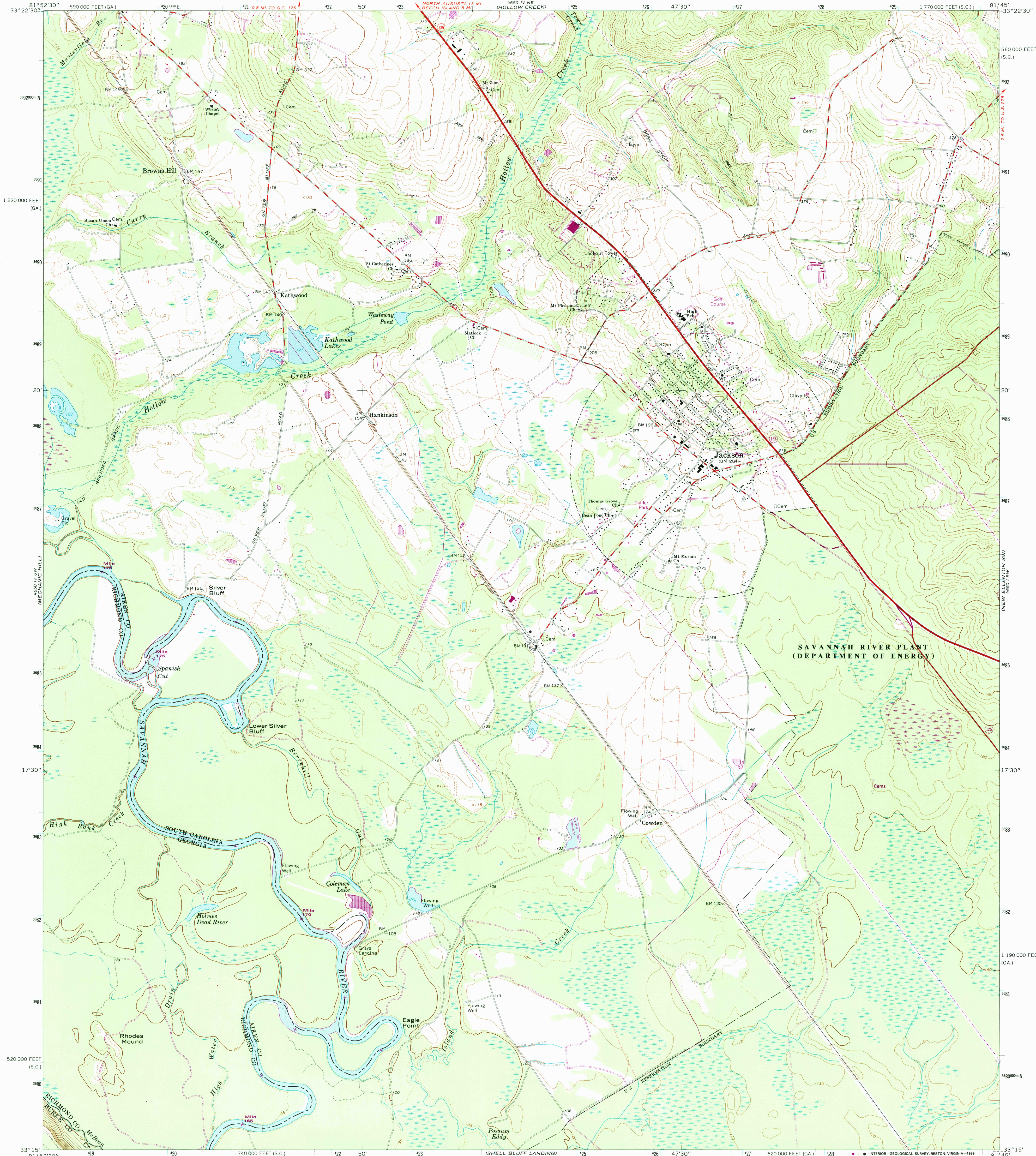


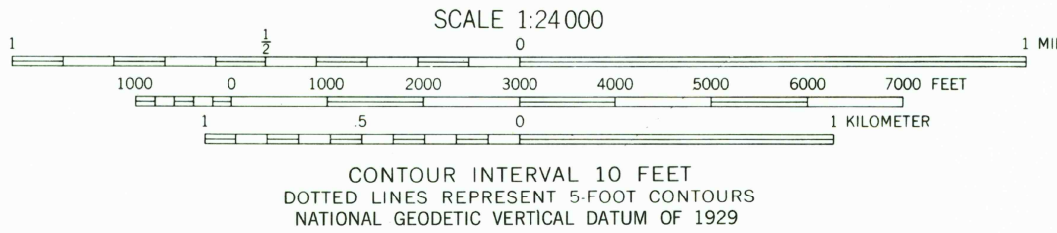

Mapped, edited, and published by the Geological Survey in cooperation with the Atomic Energy Commission. Control by USGS and USC&GS. Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1962. Field checked 1965. AEC area enlarged from 1:48 000-scale map of Savannah River Plant dated 1963. Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grids based on South Carolina coordinate system, south zone, and Georgia coordinate system, east zone. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 13 meters south and 15 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks. Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked.

There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map. Revisions shown in purple and woodland compiled from aerial photographs taken 1987 and other sources. This information not field checked. Map edited 1989.
