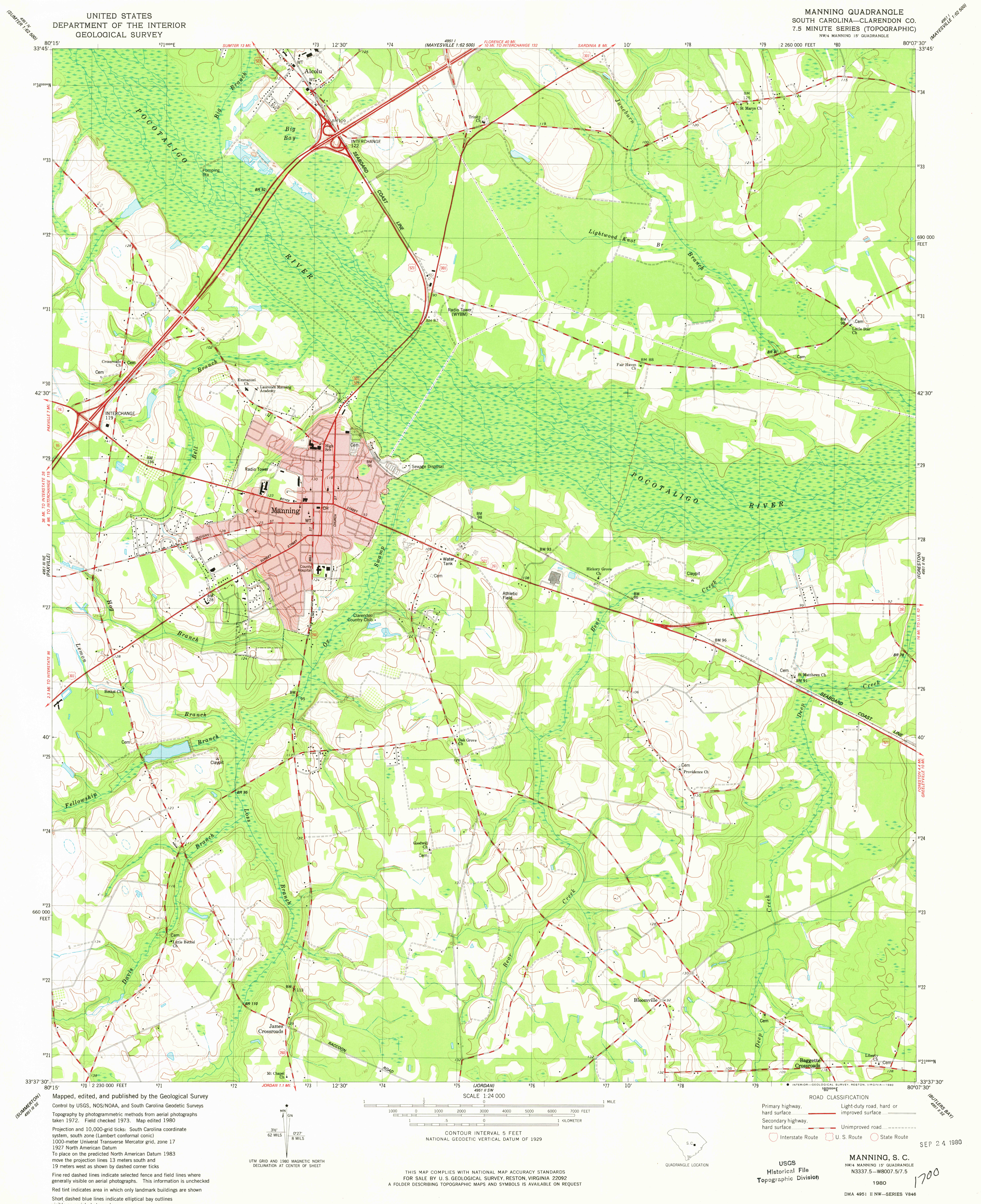
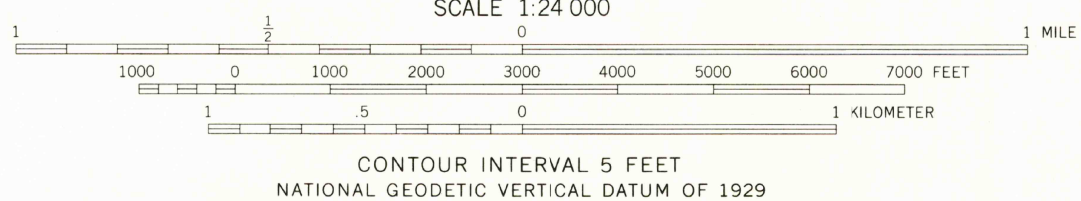
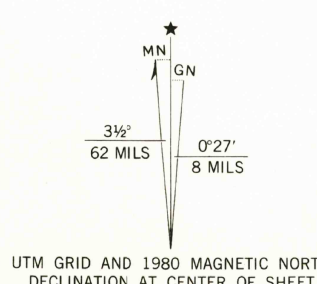

Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown
Short dashed blue lines indicate elliptical bay outlines visible on aerial photographs
