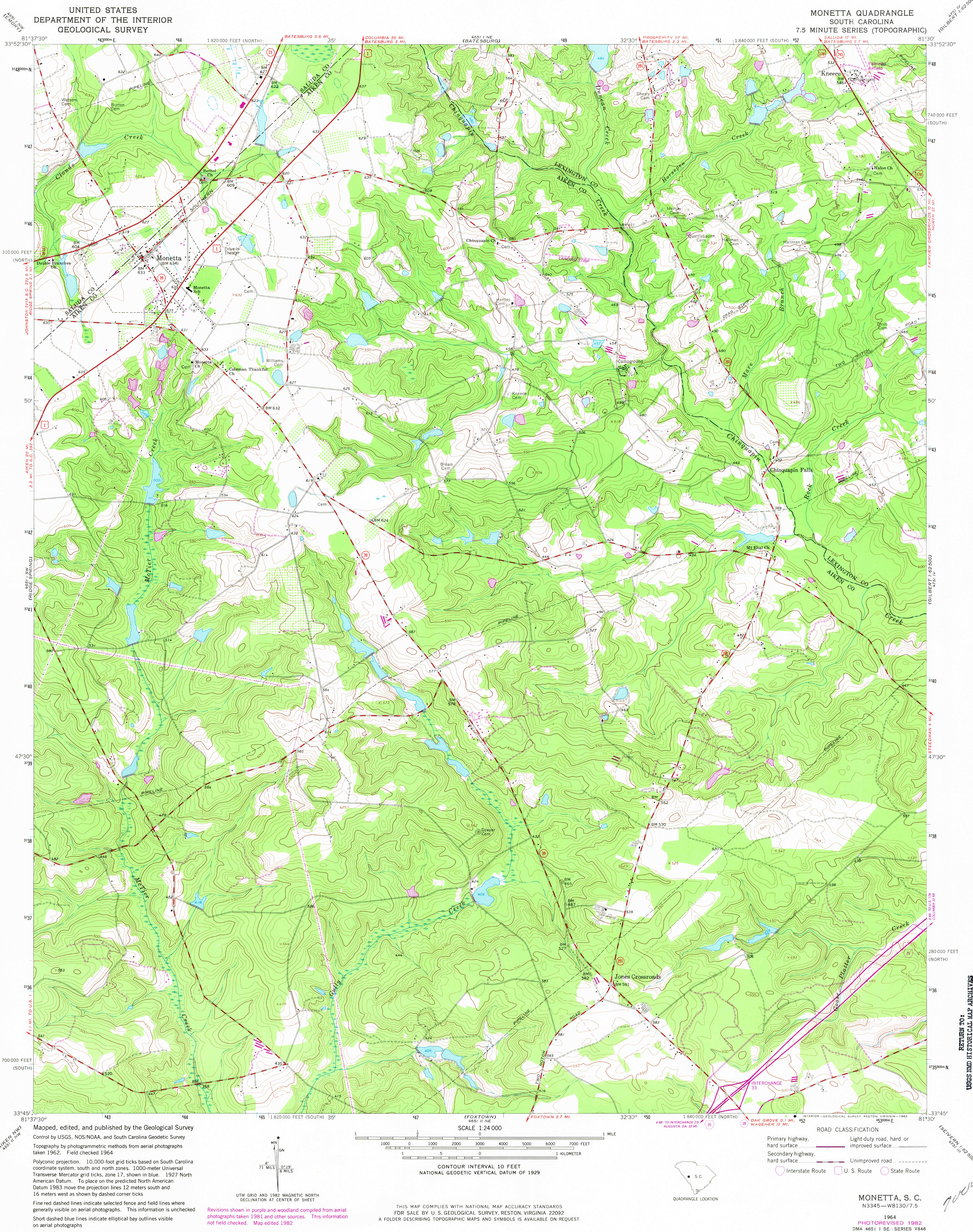

Polyconic projection. 10,000-foot grid ticks based on South Carolina coordinate system, south and north zones. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue. 1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 12 meters south and 16 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked
Short dashed blue lines indicate elliptical bay outlines visible on aerial photographs
