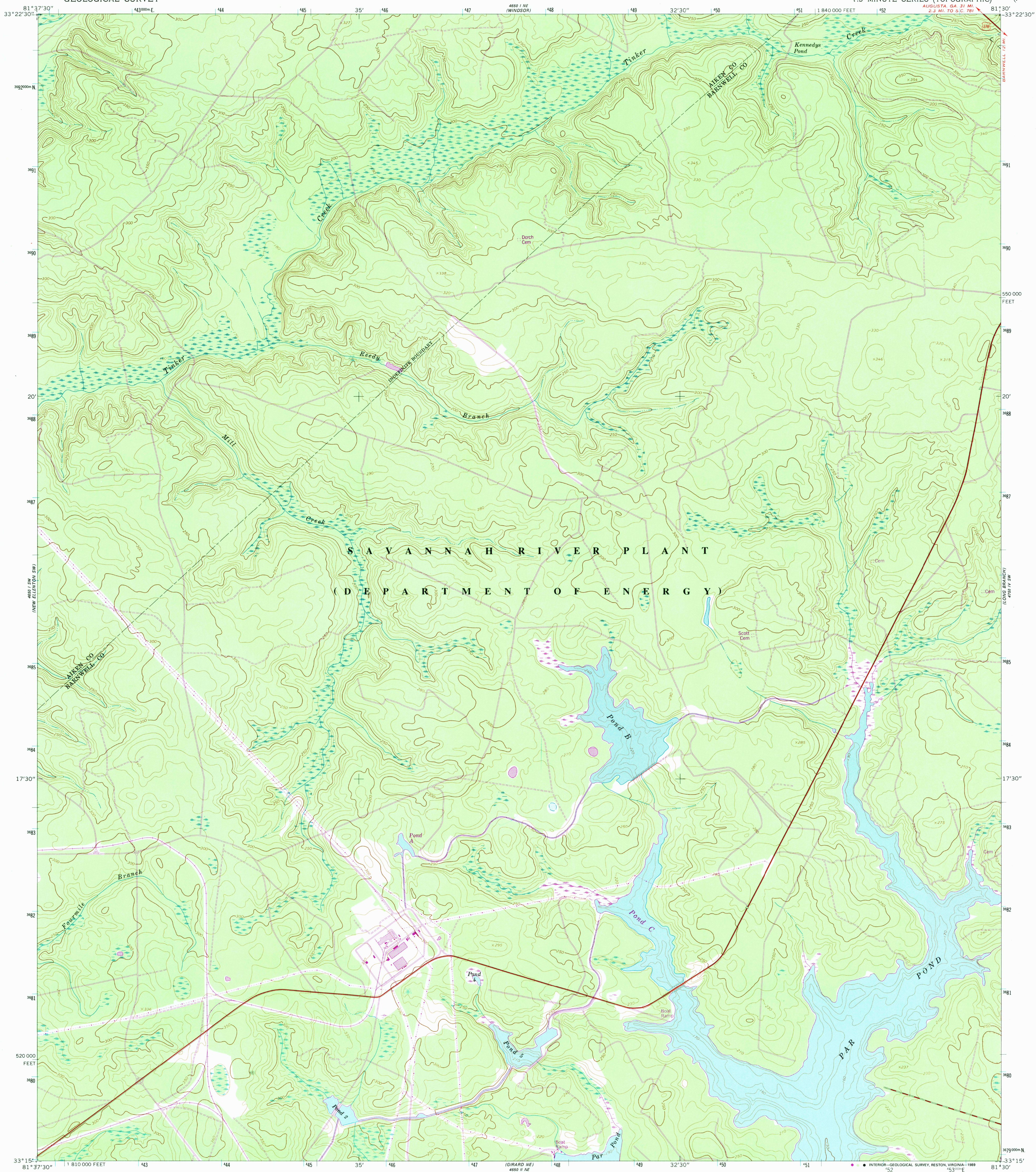

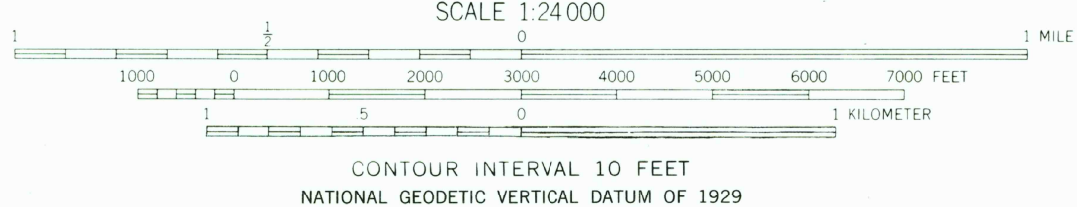
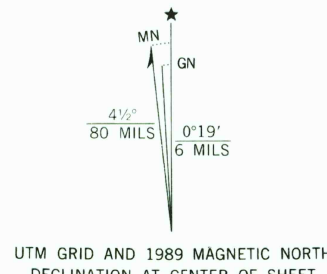
NEW ELLENTON SE QUADRANGLE
