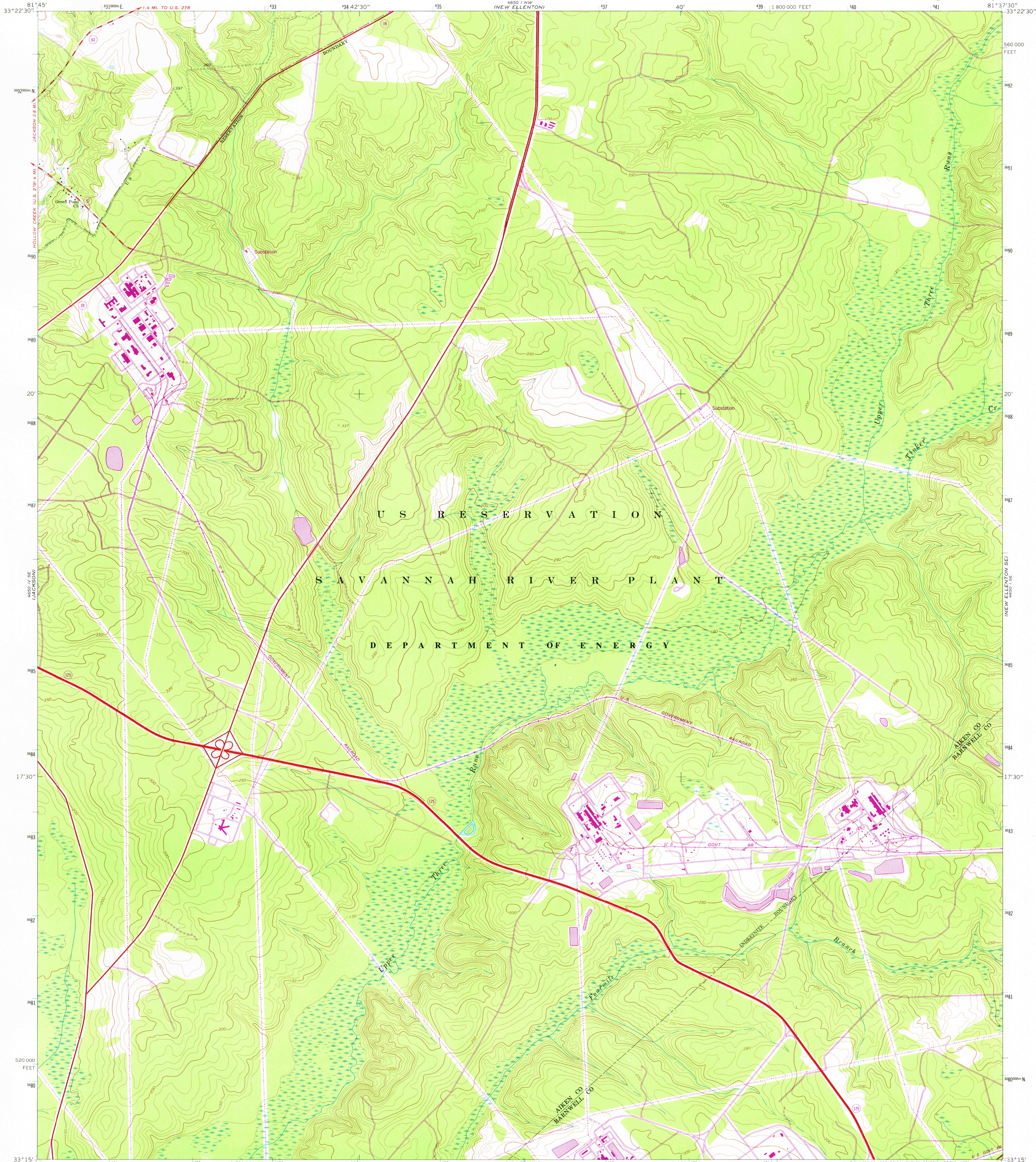

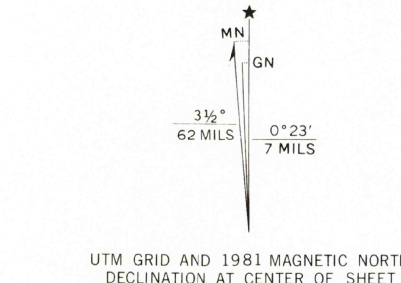
Polyconic projection. 10,000-foot grid ticks based on South

zone 17, shown in blue. 1927 North American Datum

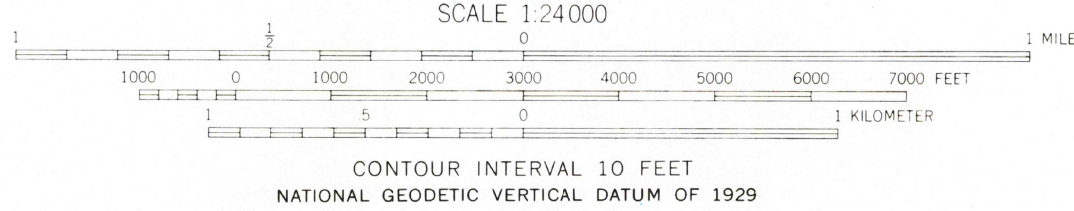
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983
