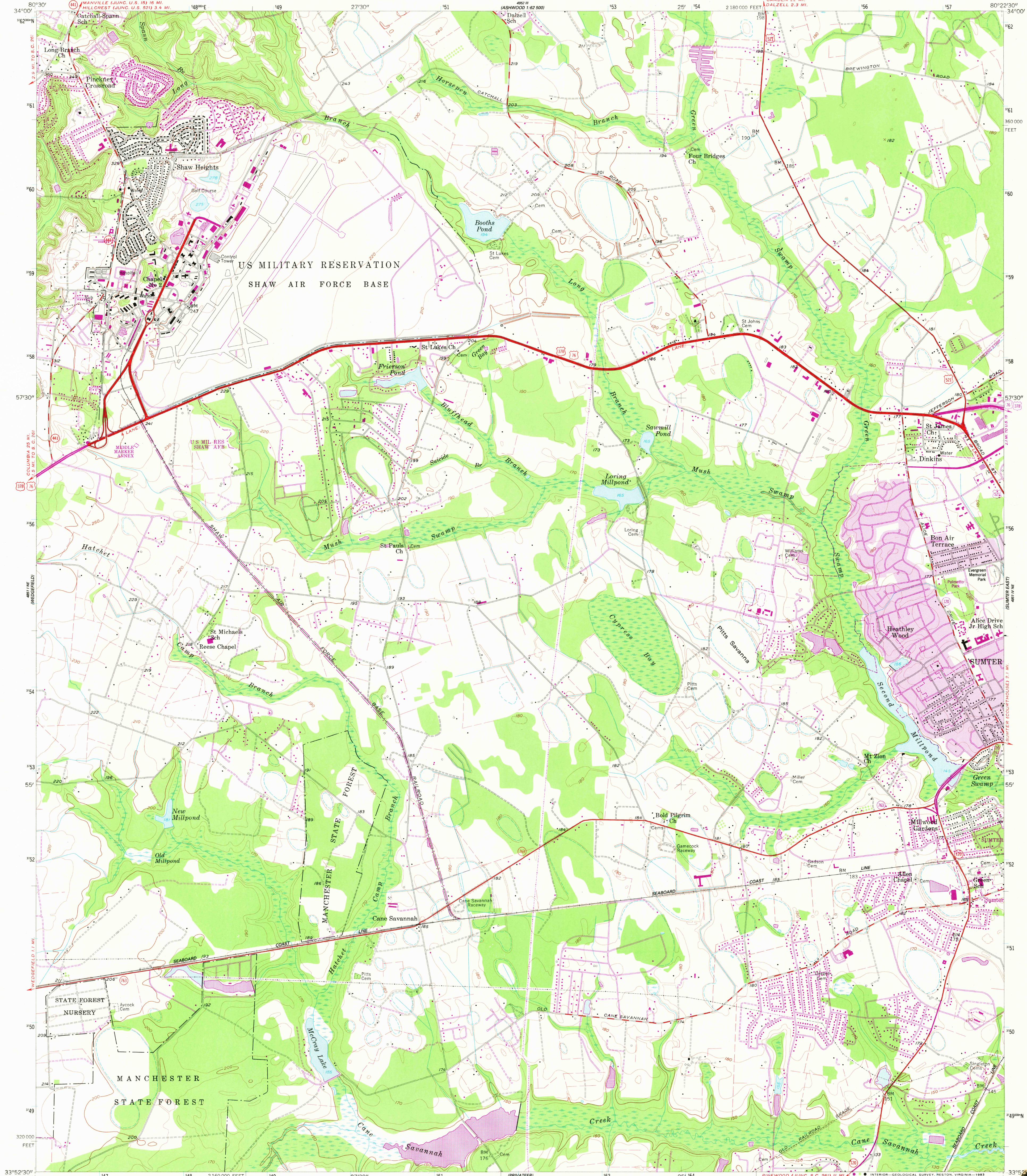

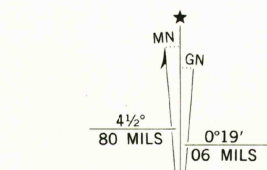

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked

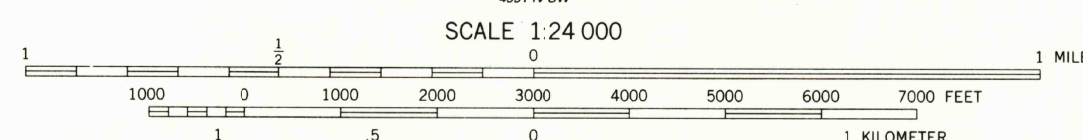
Dashed blue lines indicate elliptical bay outlines as distinguished on aerial photographs
