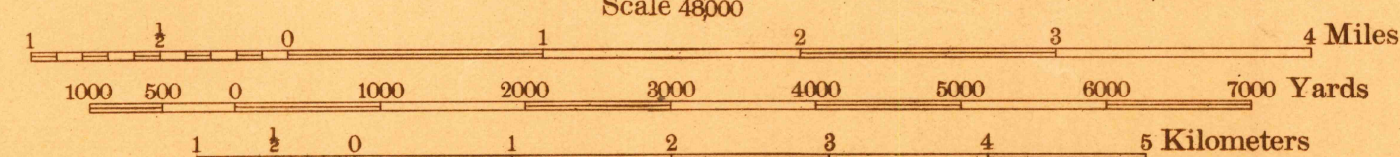

ELLENTON QUADRANGLE

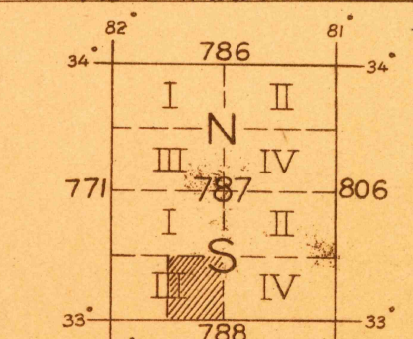
