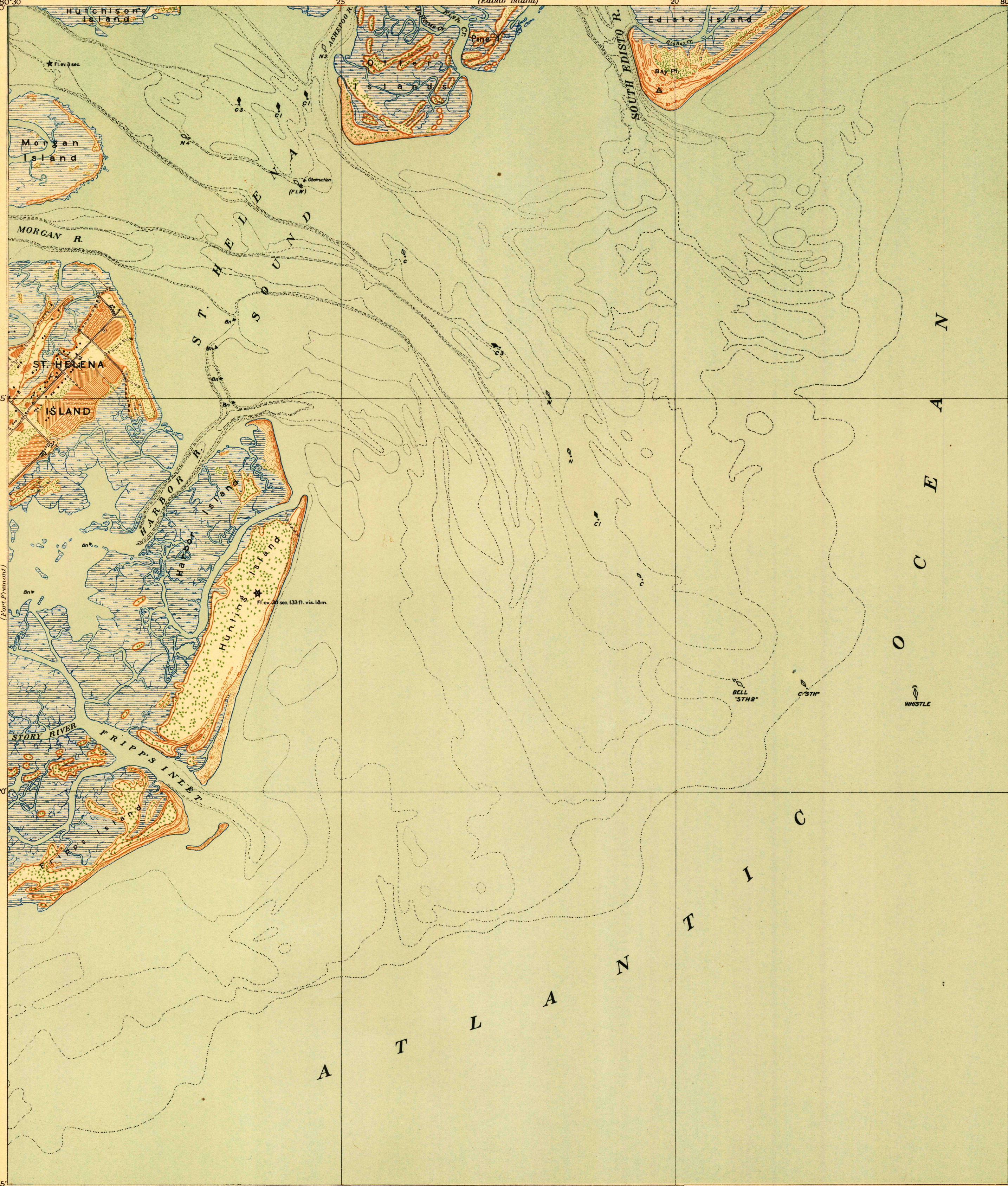

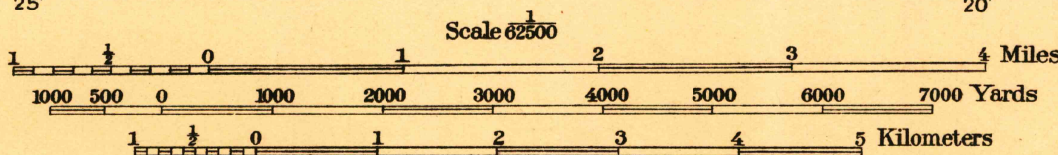

ST. HELENA SOUND QUADRANGLE



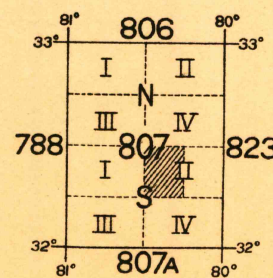
