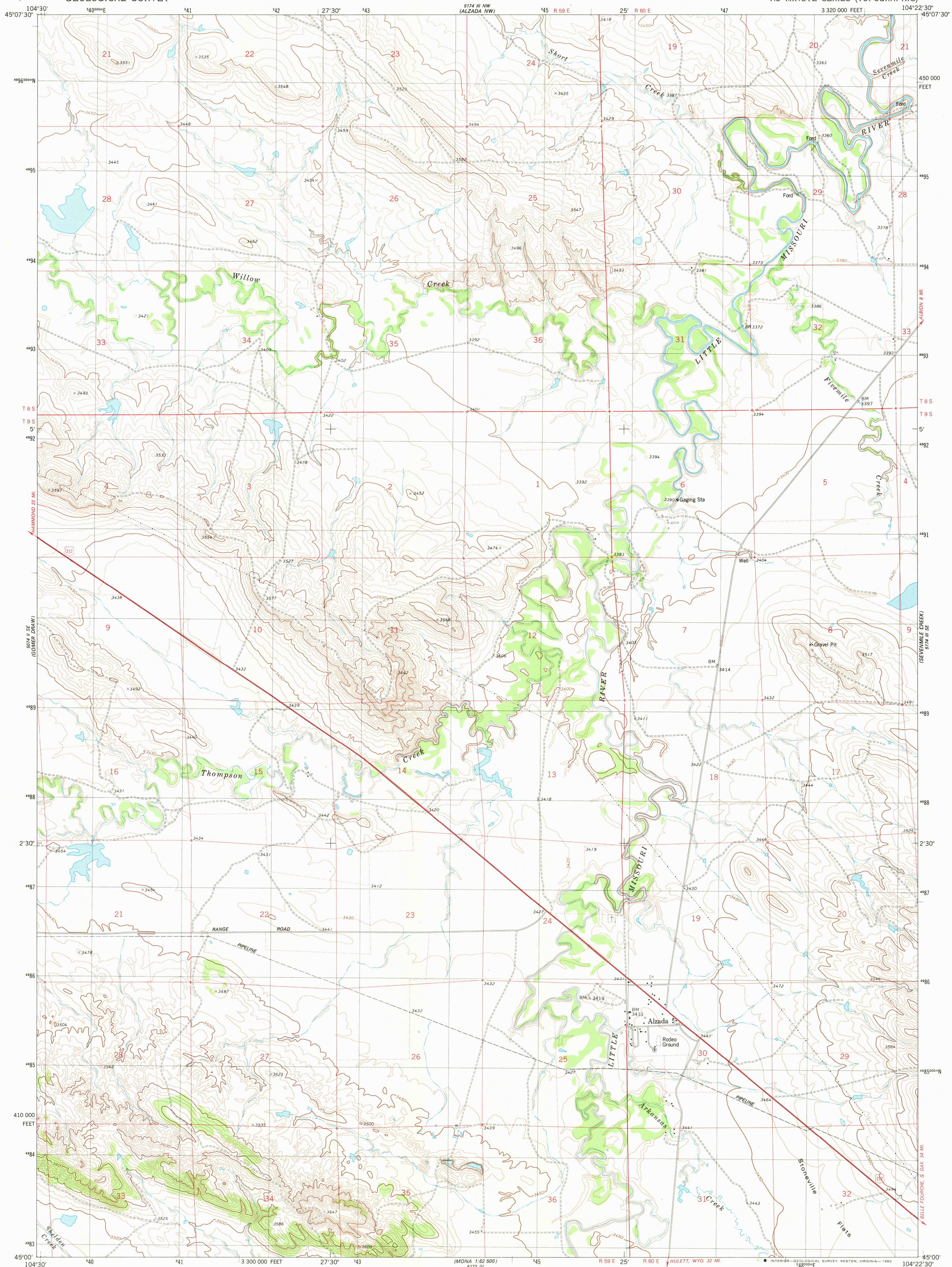

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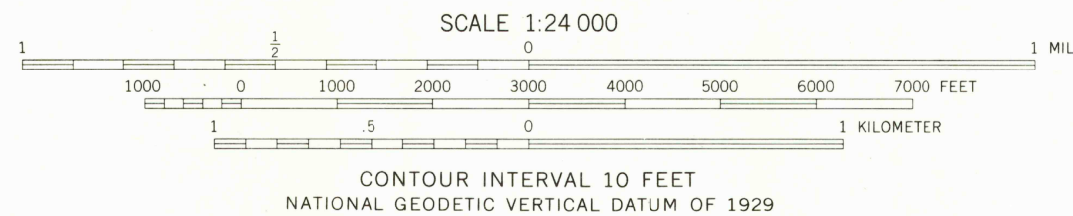
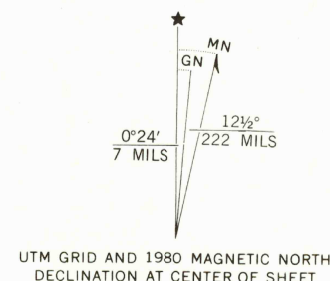

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 13 1927 North American datum

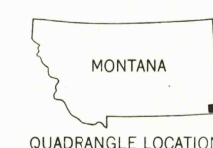
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 5 meters north and 42 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
