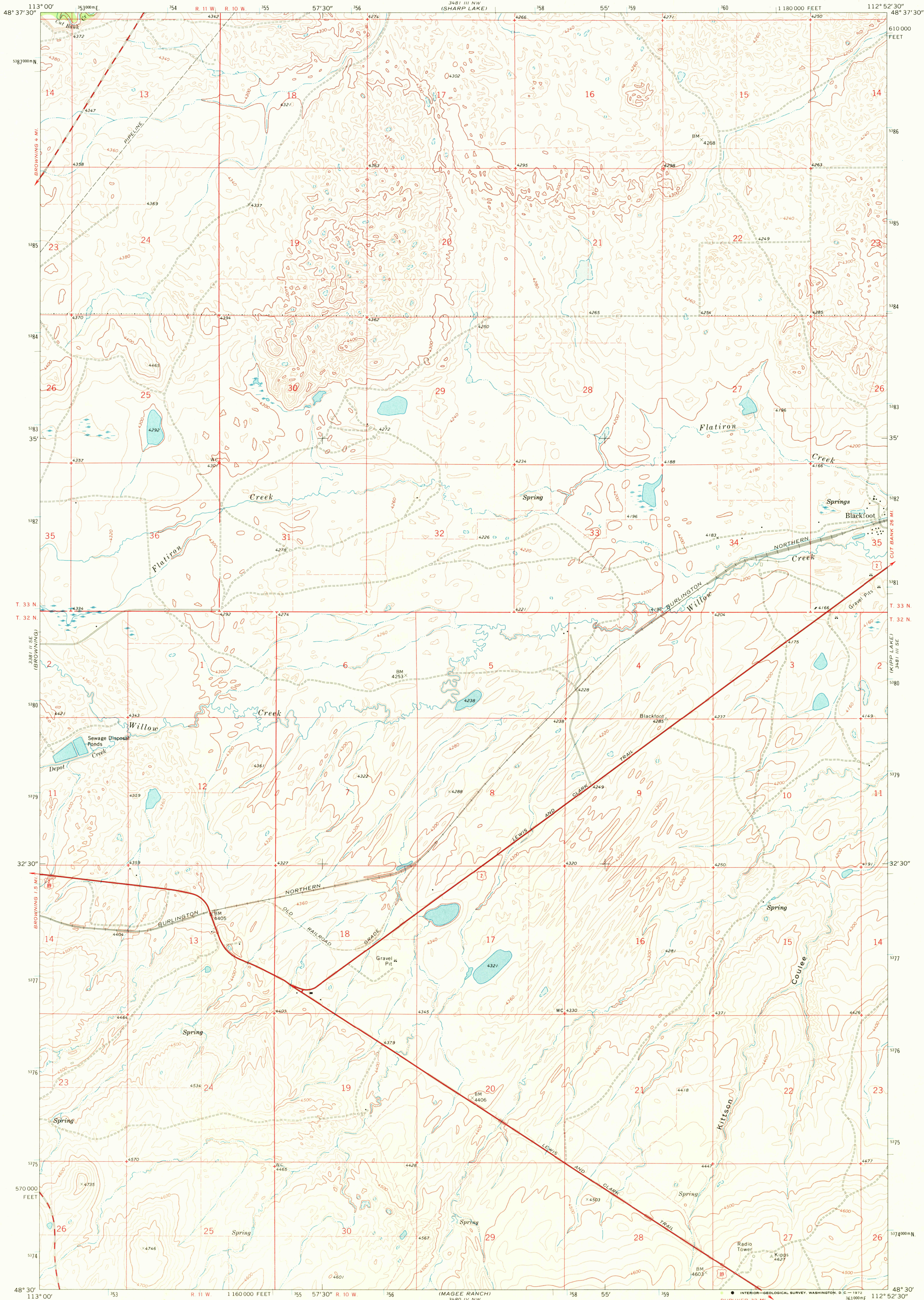

zone 12

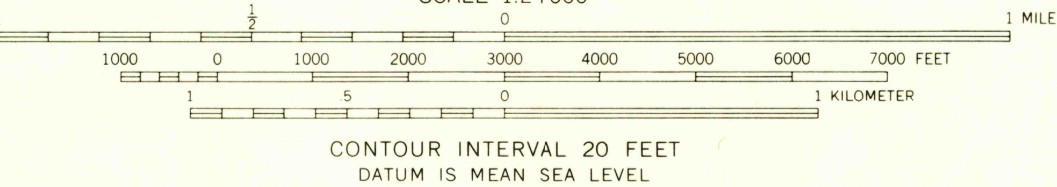
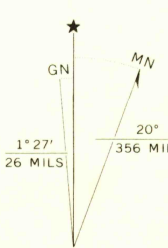
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
