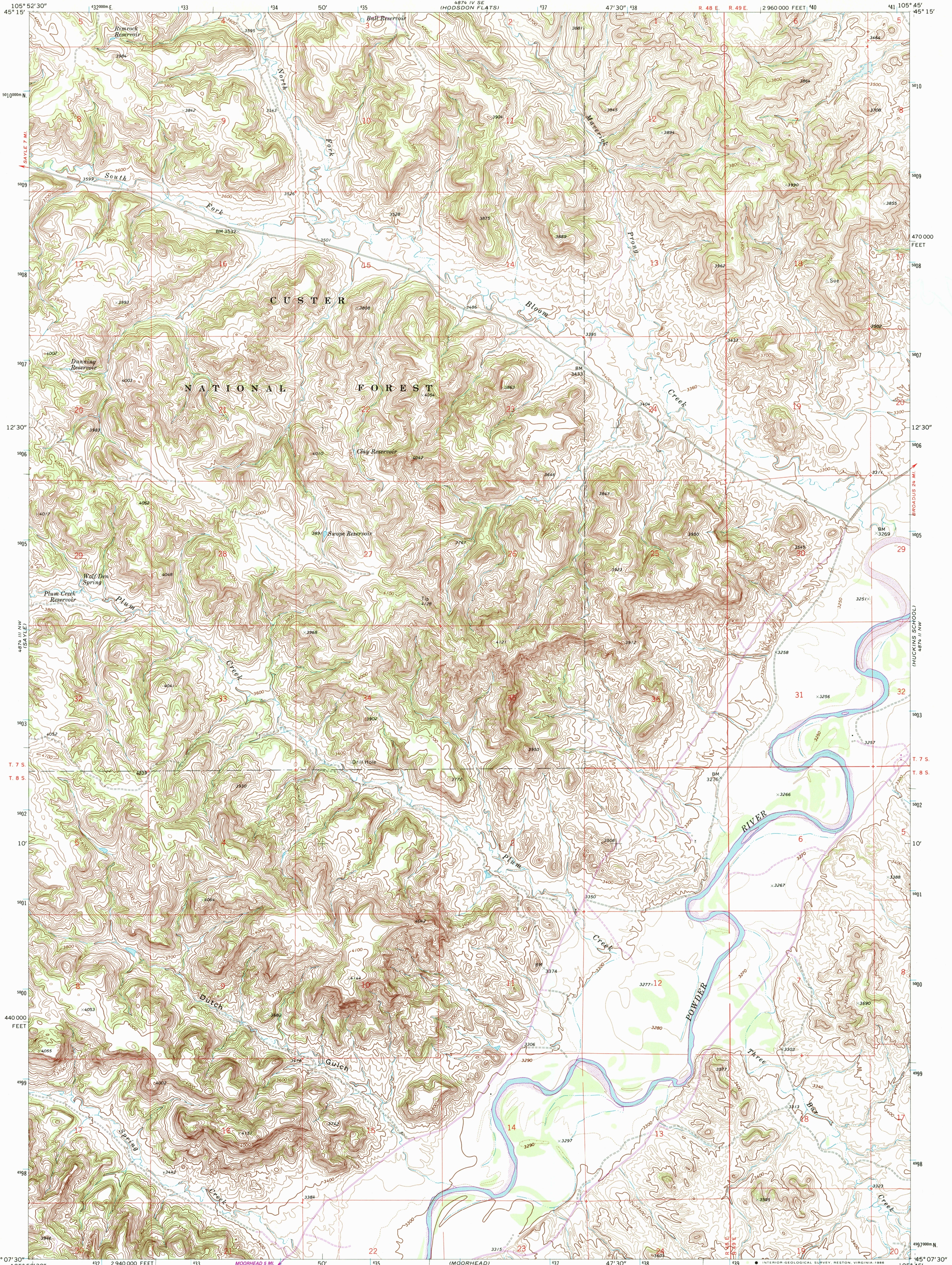

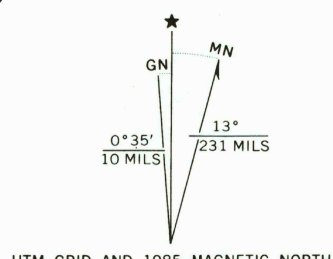
10,000-foot grid based on Montana coordinate system, south zone
