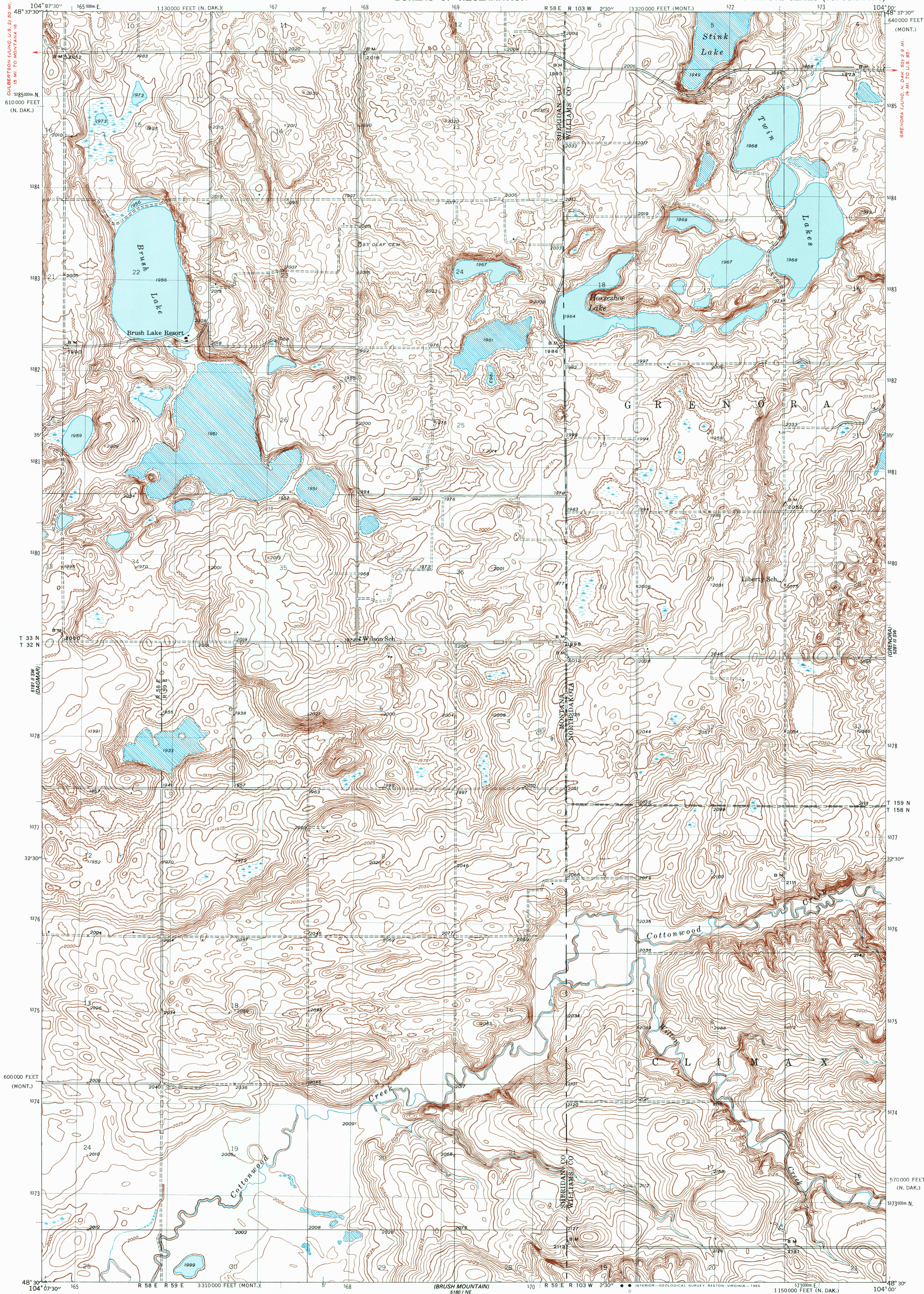

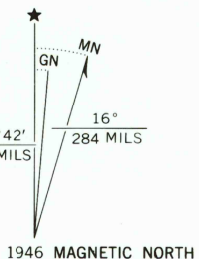

shown in black

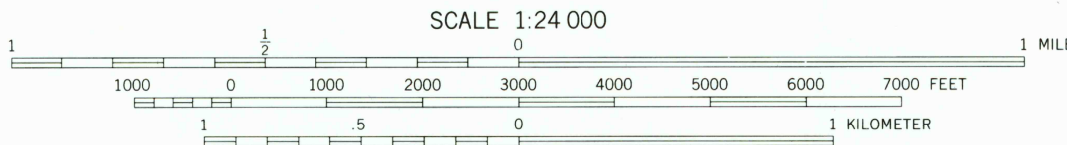
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983
