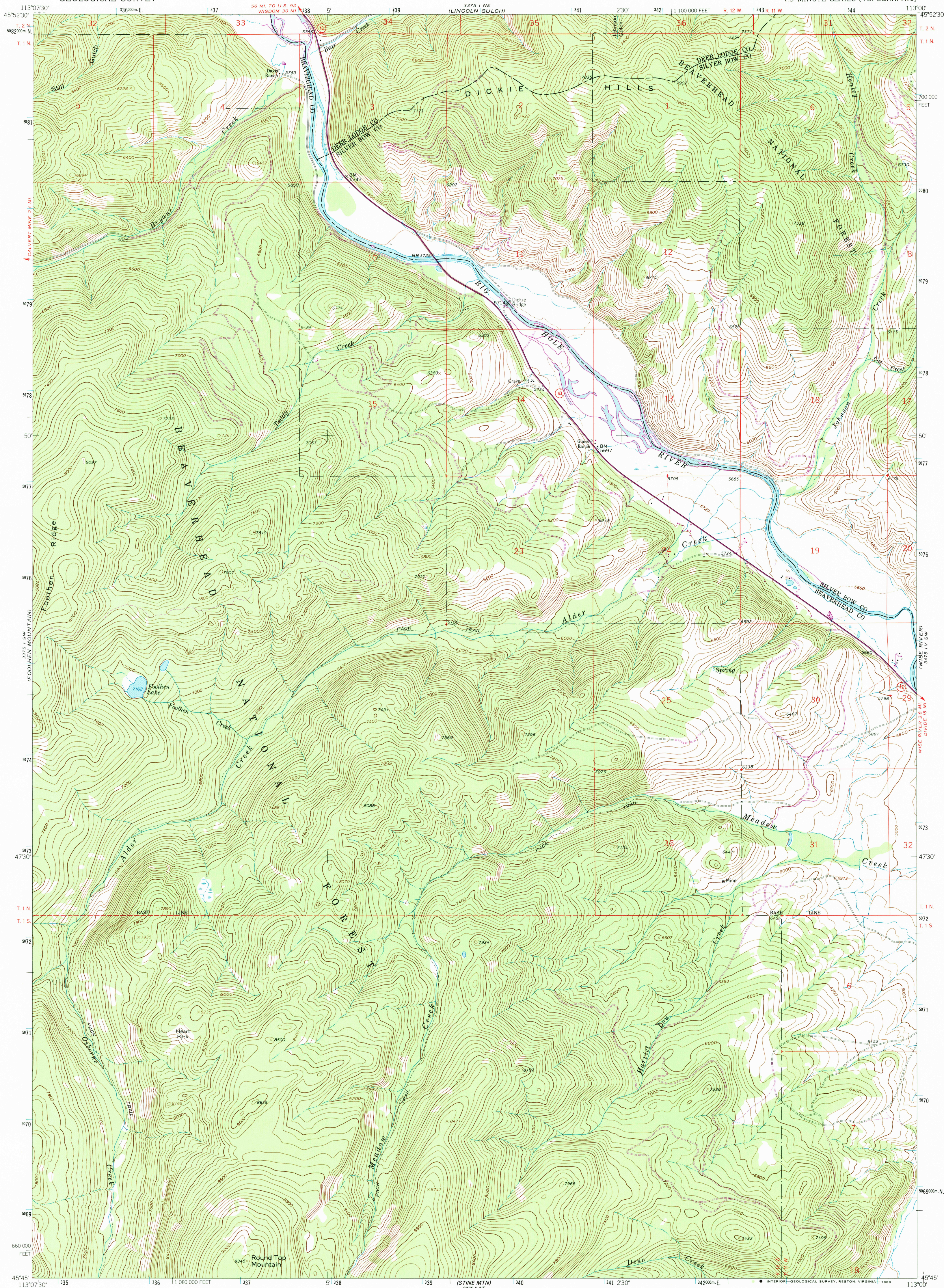

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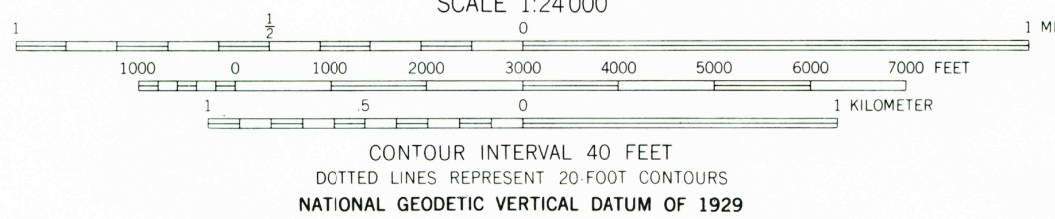
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1955. Field checked 1962

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 12 meters north and 68 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
