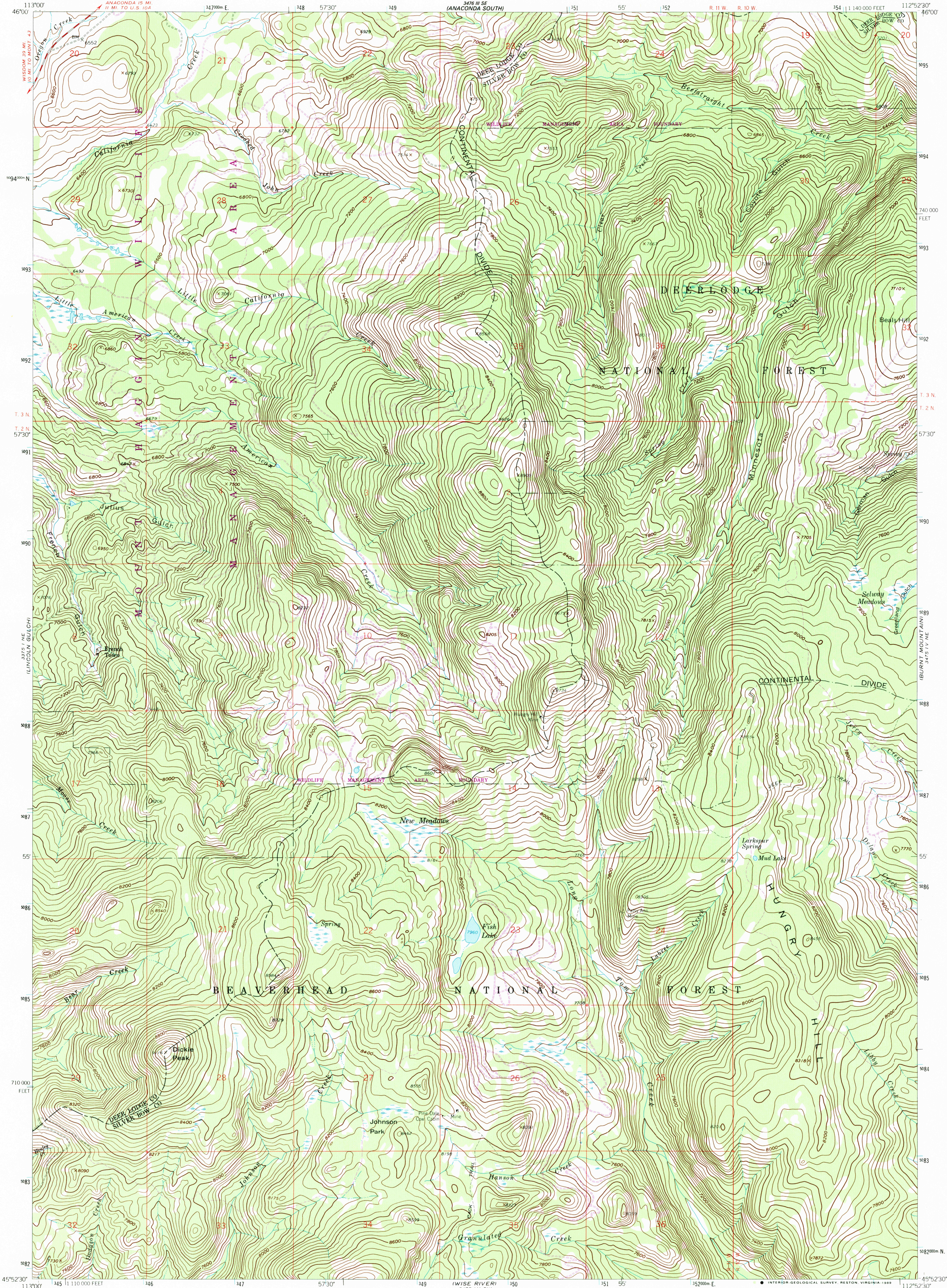

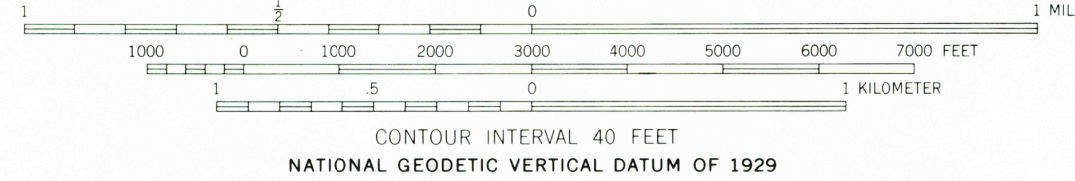
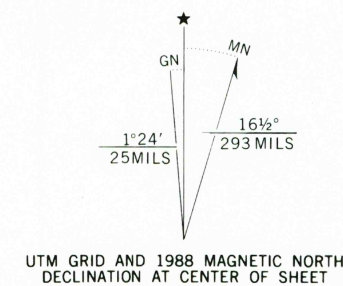
Polycyclic projection: 1927 North American Datum

Where omitted, land lines have not been established

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 11 meters north and 68 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
