

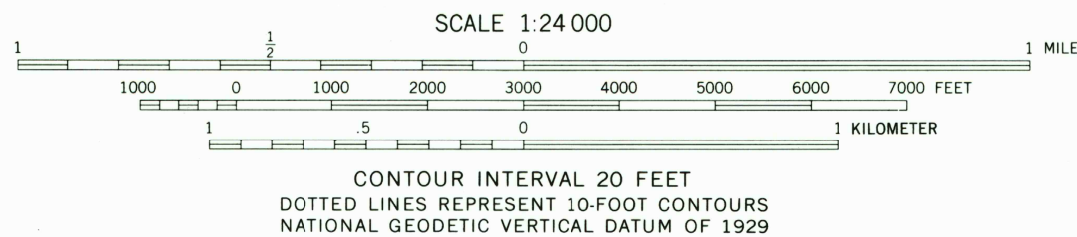

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grids based on Montana coordinate system, central and north zones 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue. Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 2 meters north and 39 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.
