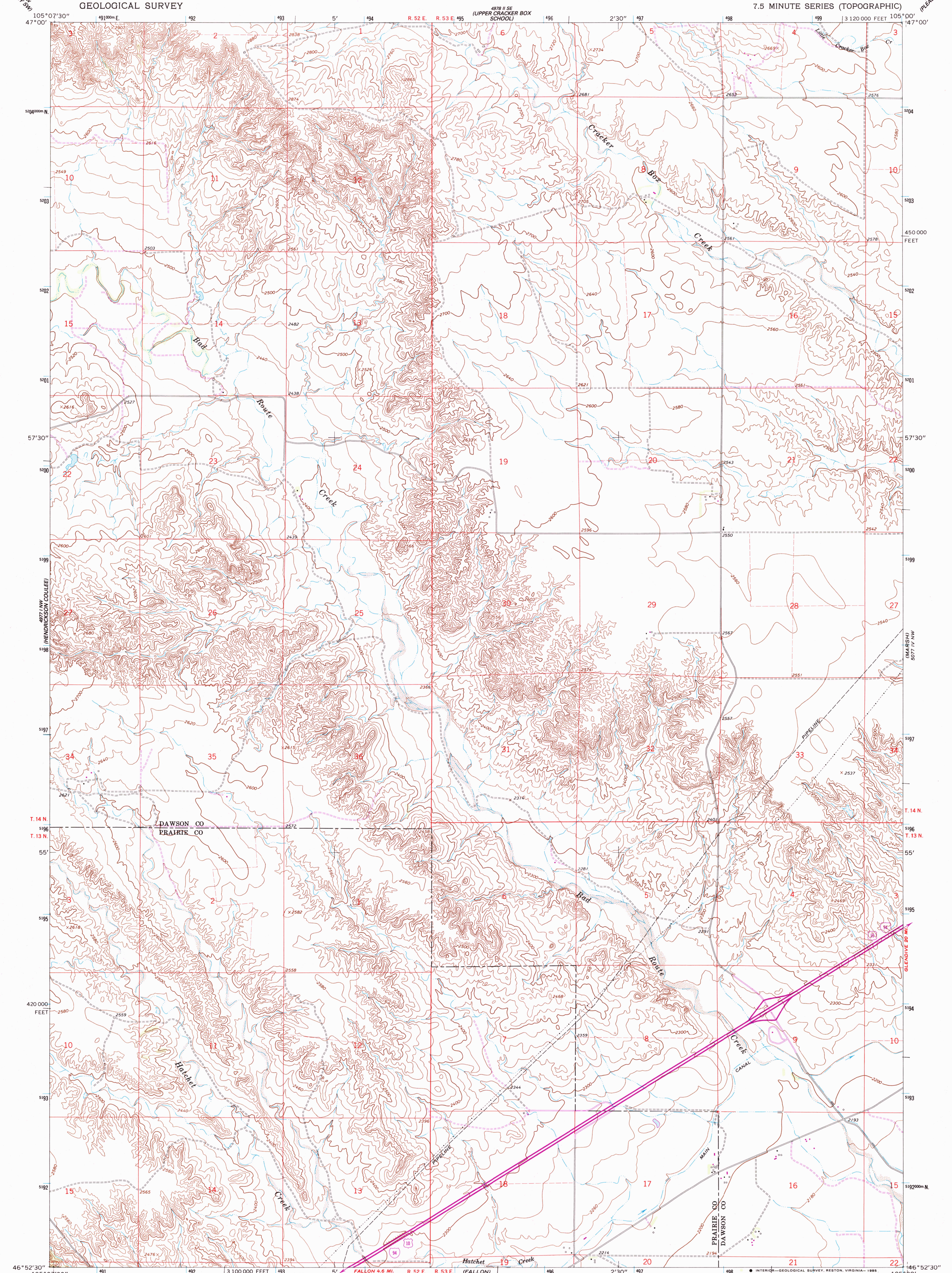

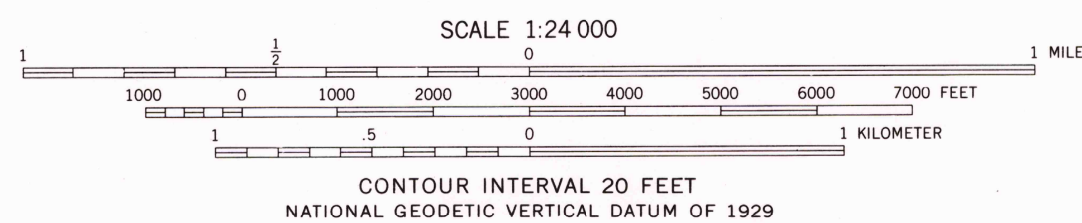

Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1965. Field checked 1967. Polyconic projection, 1927 North American Datum 10,000-foot grid based on Montana coordinate system, central zone. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue. Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 5 meters north and 43 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.

Revisions shown in purple compiled from aerial photographs taken 1980 and other source data. This information not field checked. Map edited 1983.
