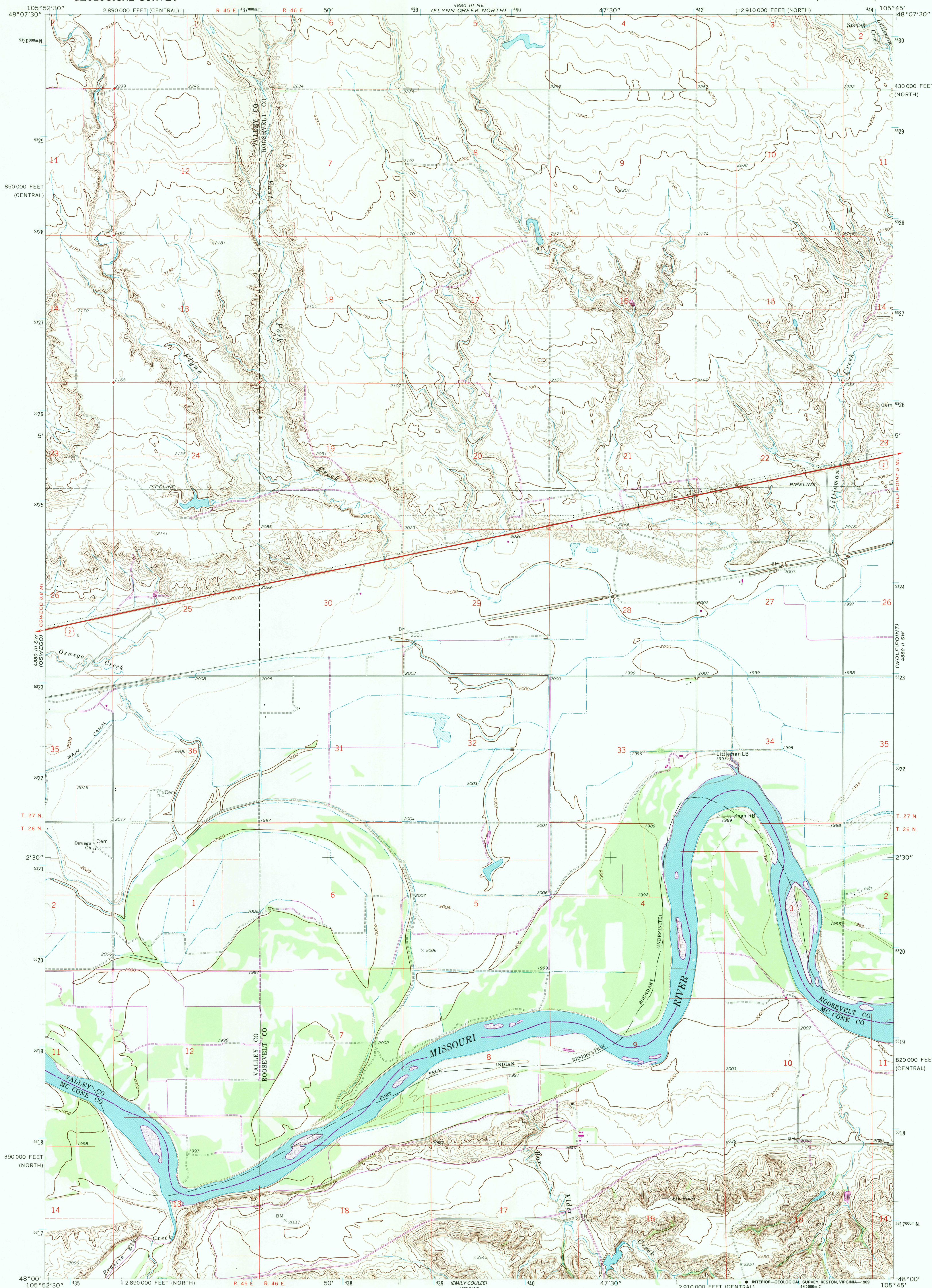

Projection: Montana coordinate system, north zone (Lambert conformal conic)

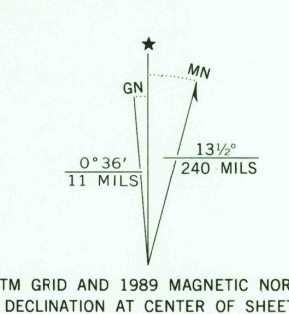
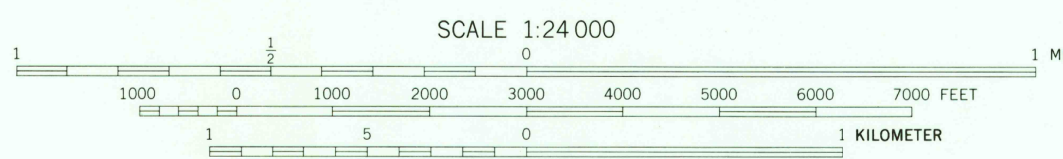
10,000-foot grid ticks based on Montana coordinate system, north and central zones

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 3 meters north and 44 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
