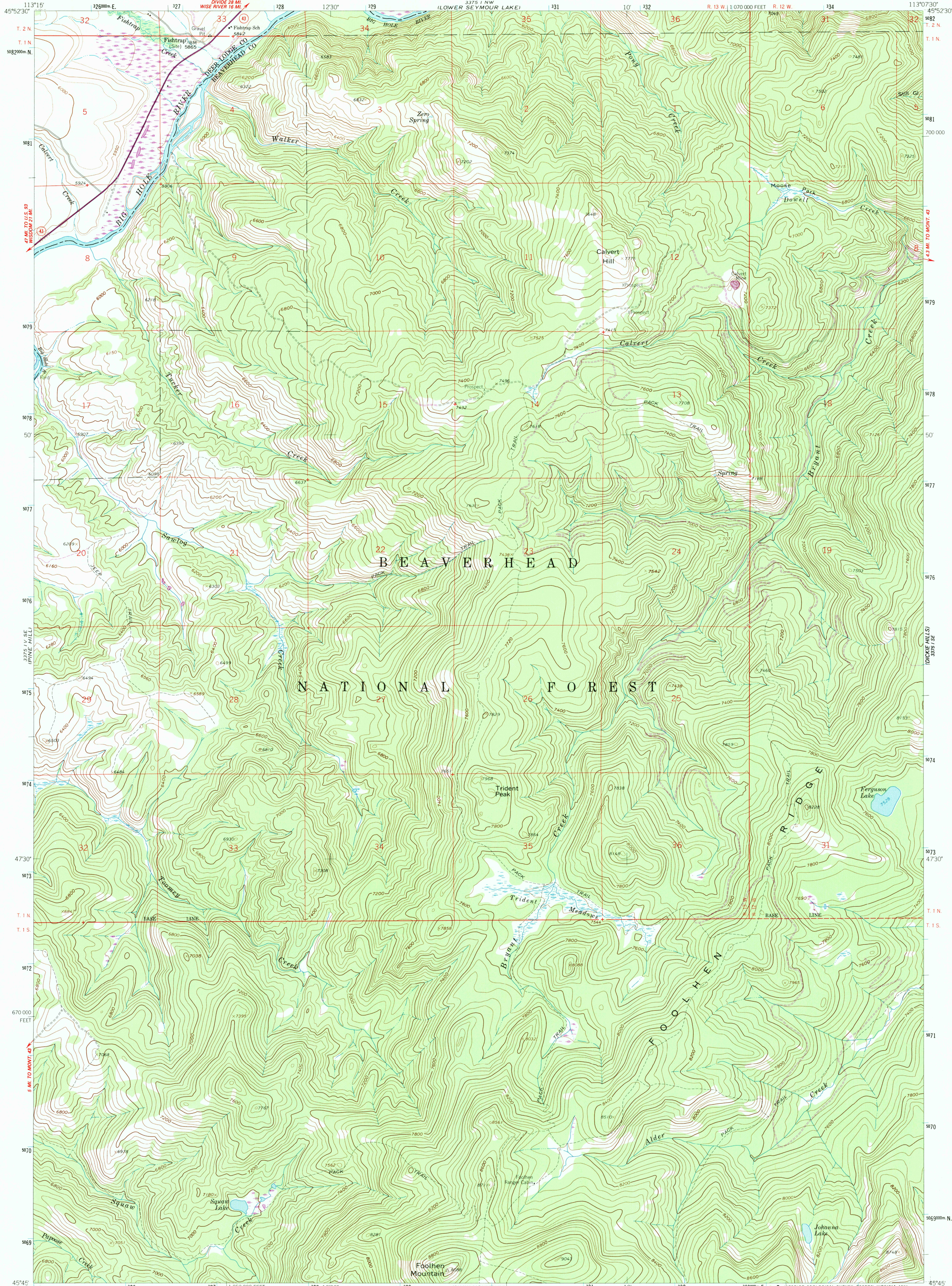

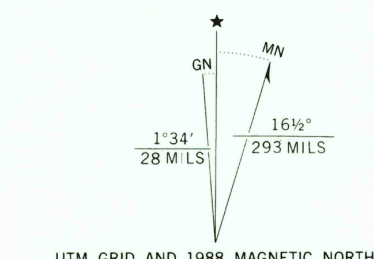

zone 12, shown in blue

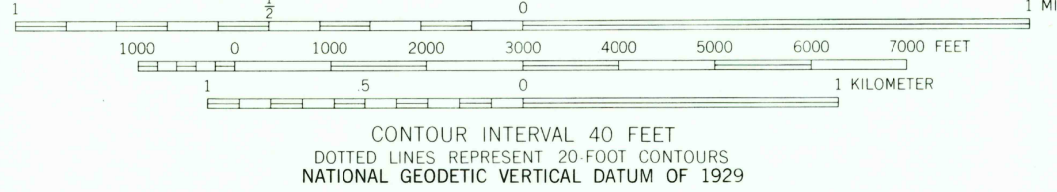
Where omitted, land lines have not been established

68 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

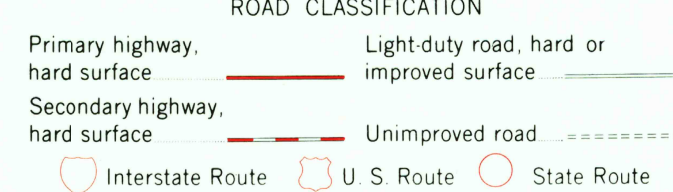
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of
