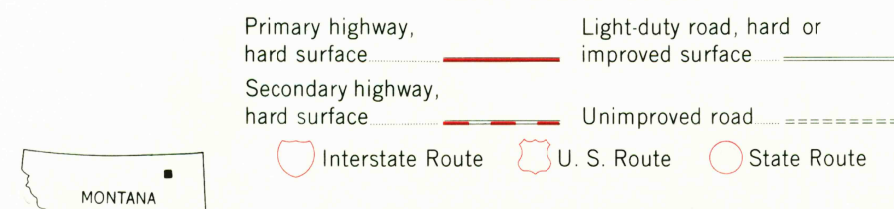
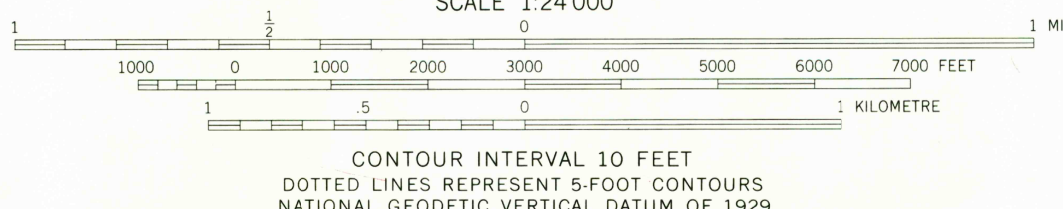
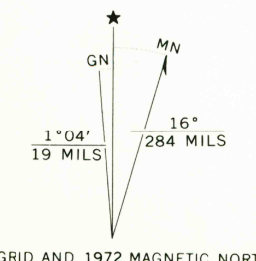
Projection: Montana coordinate system, north zone (Lambert conformal conic)
