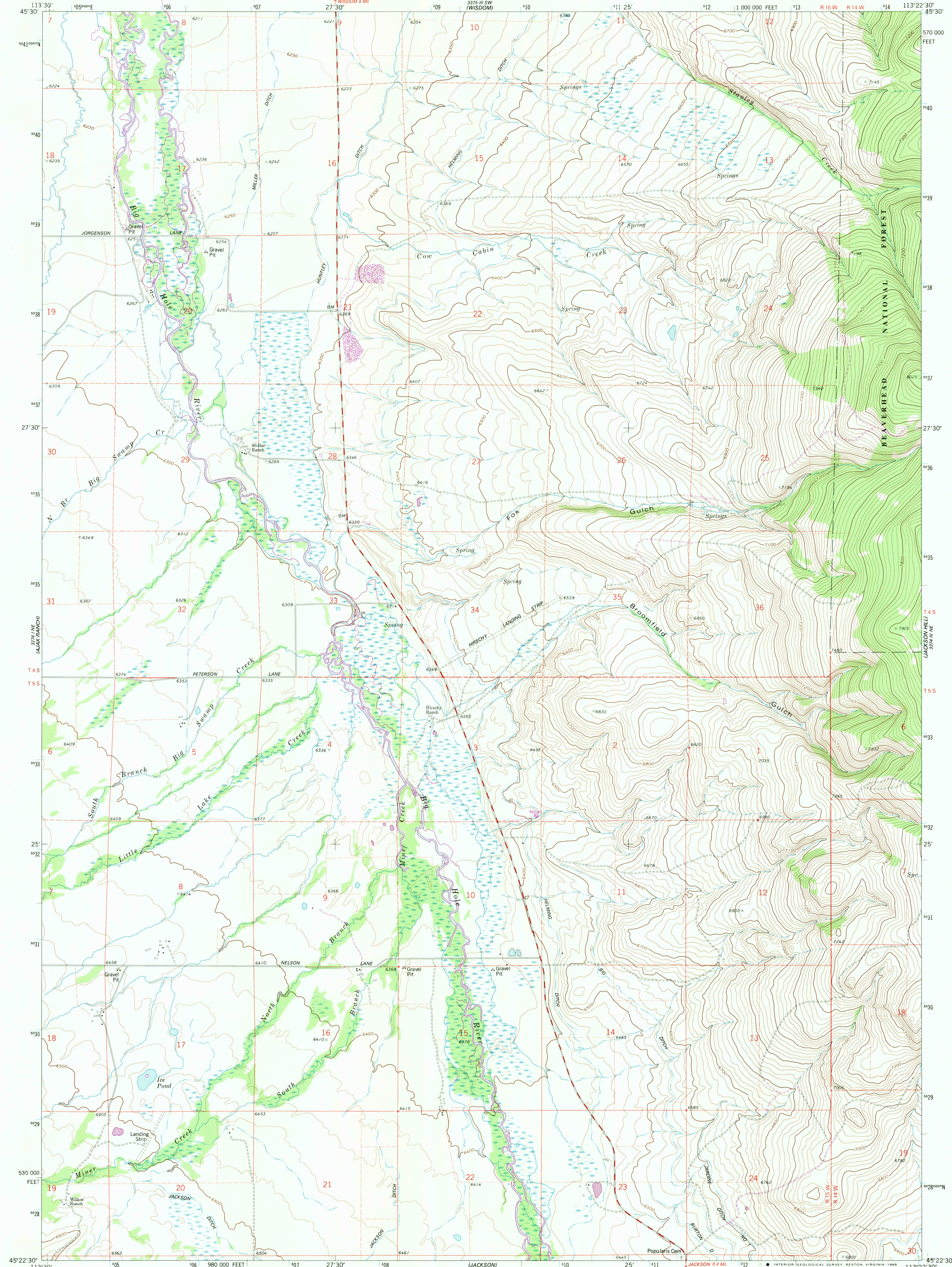

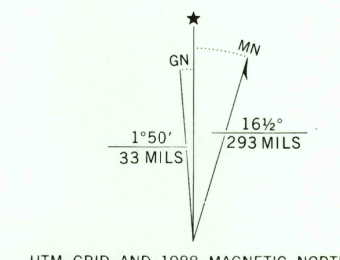

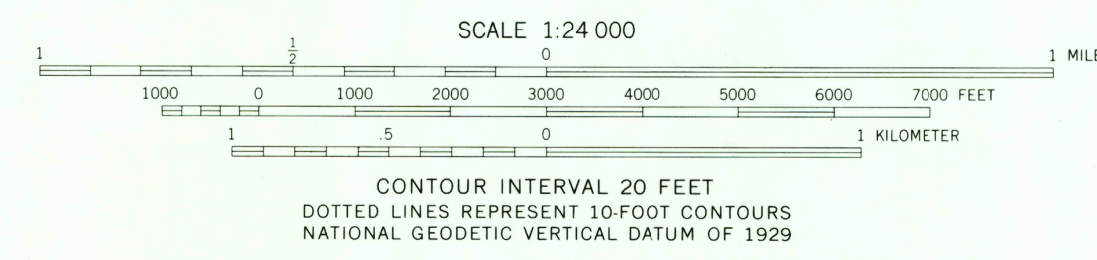
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines. Where omitted, land lines have not been established or are not shown because of insufficient data

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 12 north and 69 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

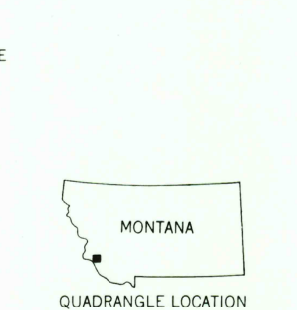


UTM GRID AND 1988 MAGNETIC NORTH DECLINATION AT CENTER OF SHEET
