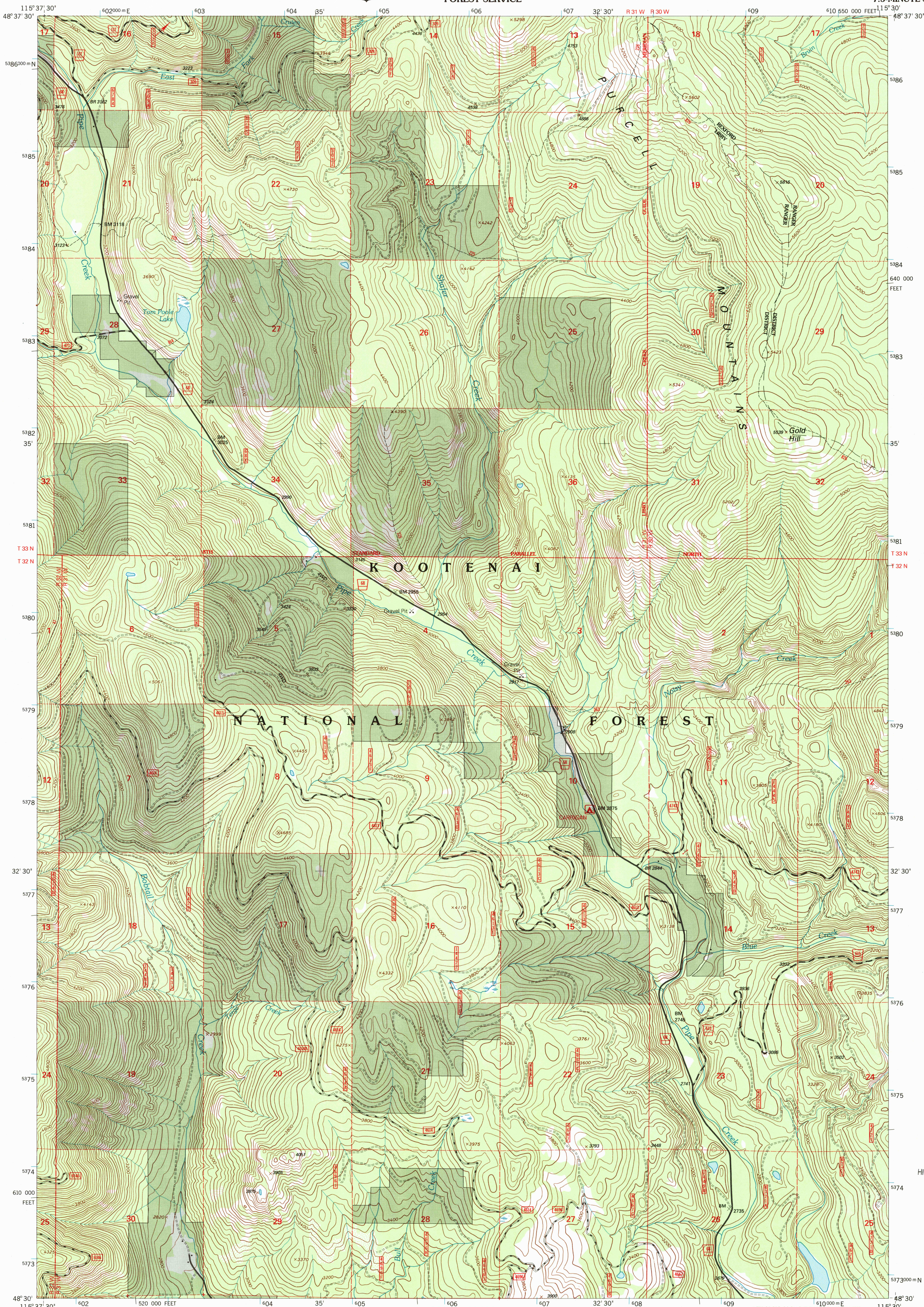

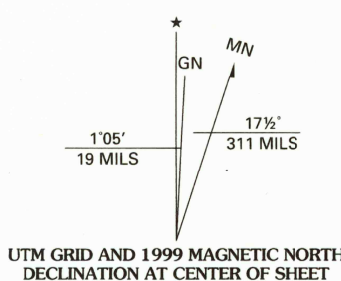
North American Datum of 1927 (NAD 27). Projection and 10 000-foot ticks: Montana coordinate system, north zone (Lambert conformal conic)
