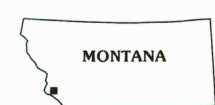

QUADRANGLE LOCATION

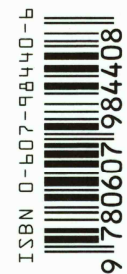
