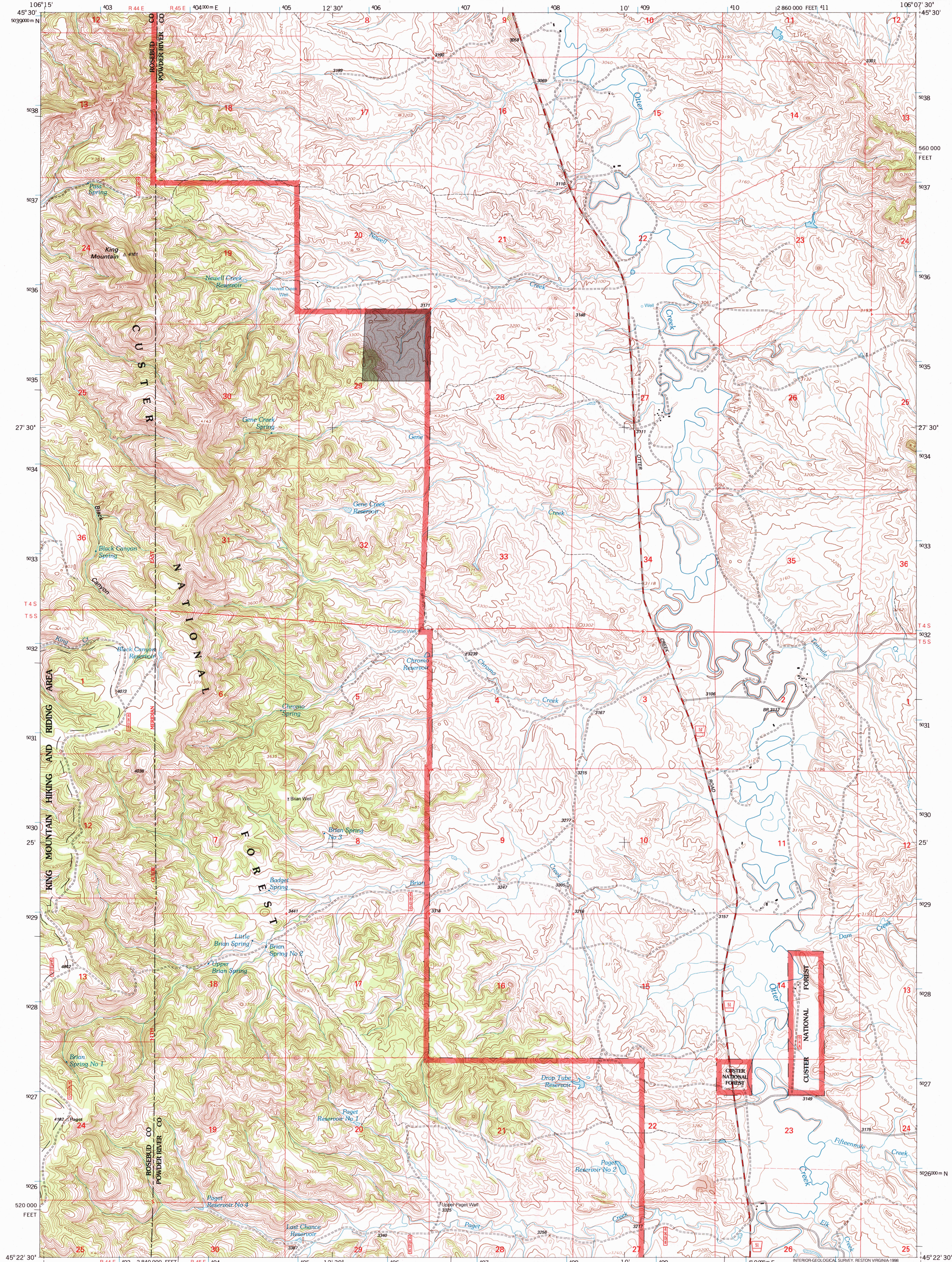

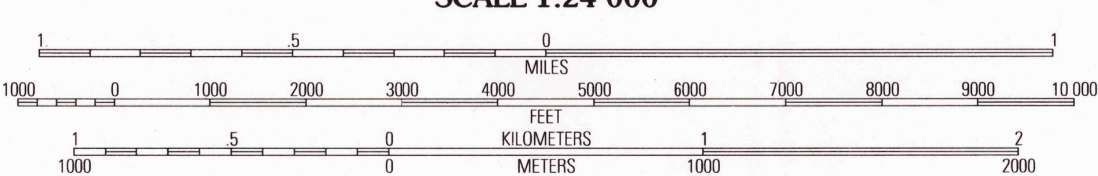
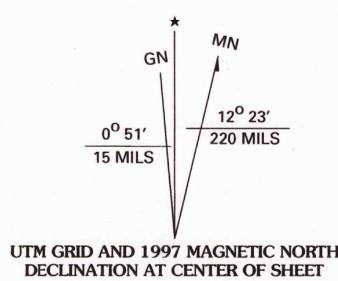

intersections are obtainable from National Geodetic Survey NADCON software.

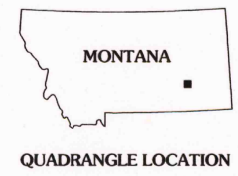
