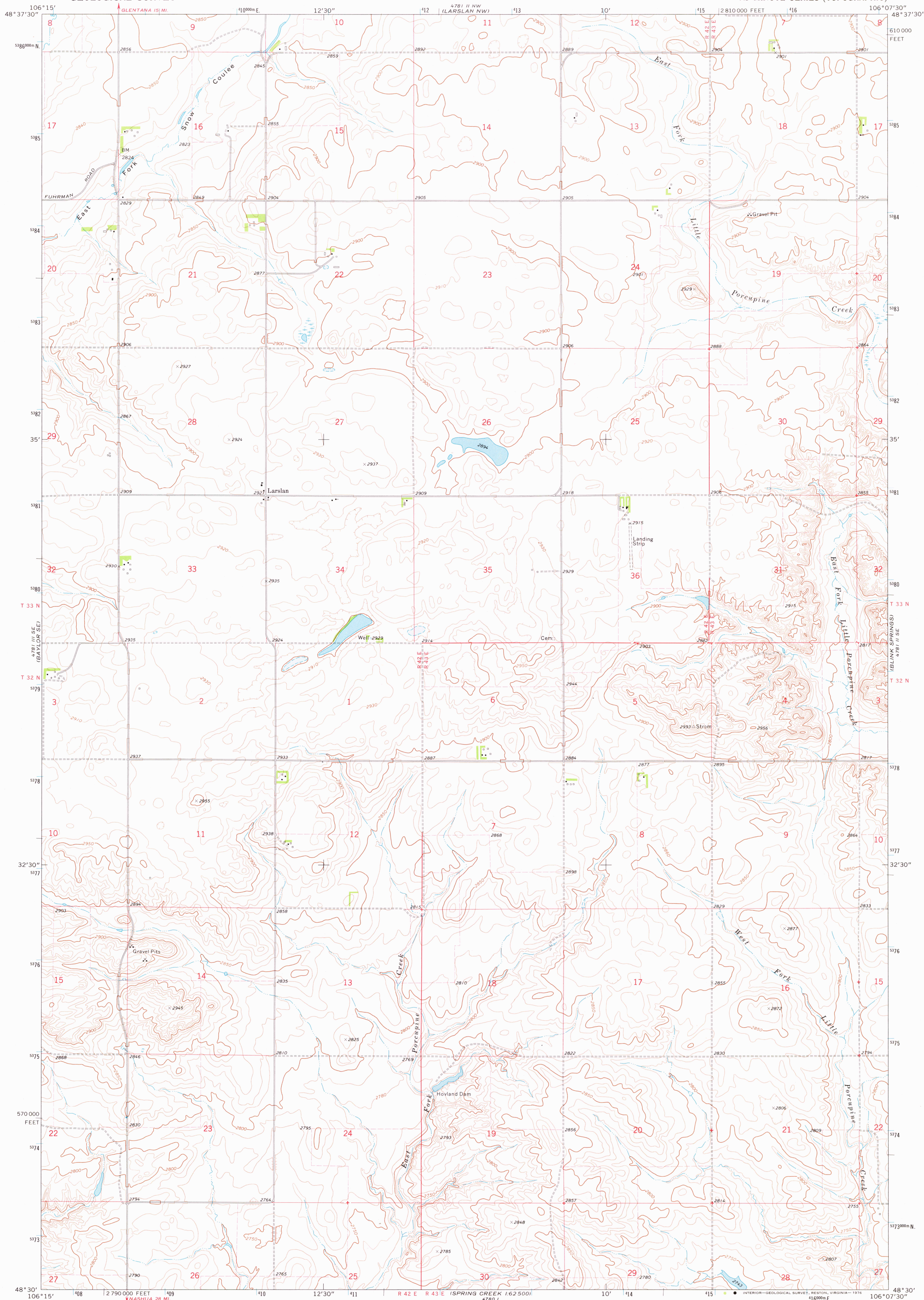

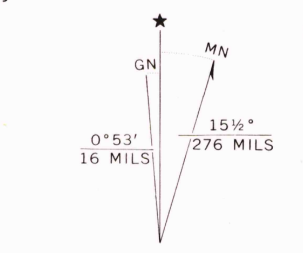

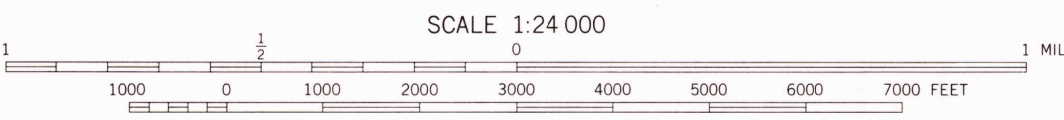

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines

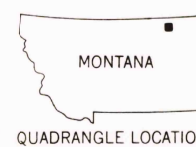
Entire area lies within the boundary of Fort Peck Indian Reservation
