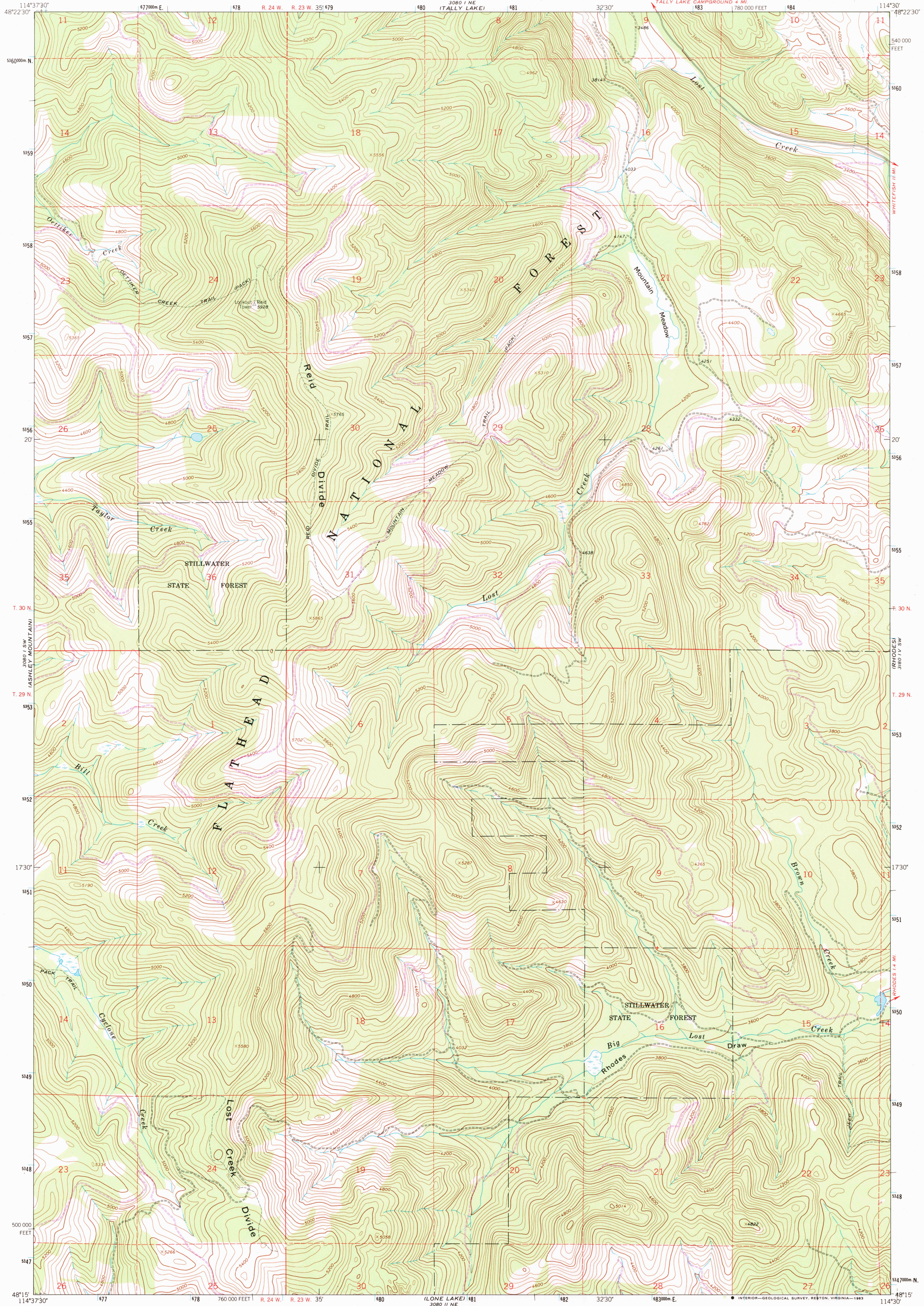

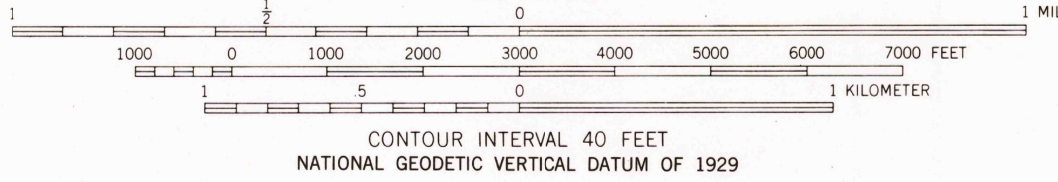
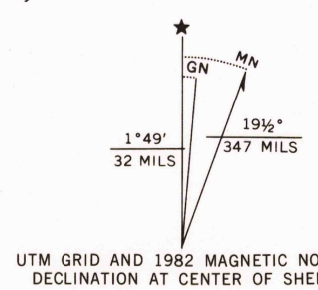
LOST CREEK DIVIDE QUADRANGLE
