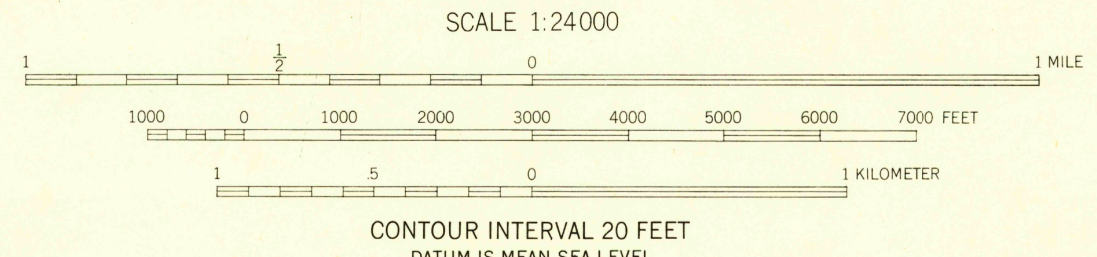
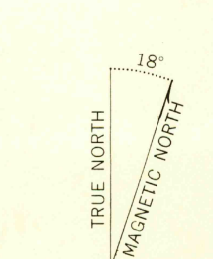
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Topography from aerial photographs by multiplex methods by the Geological Survey and Tennessee Valley Authority. Aerial photographs taken 1948. Field check 1951.
