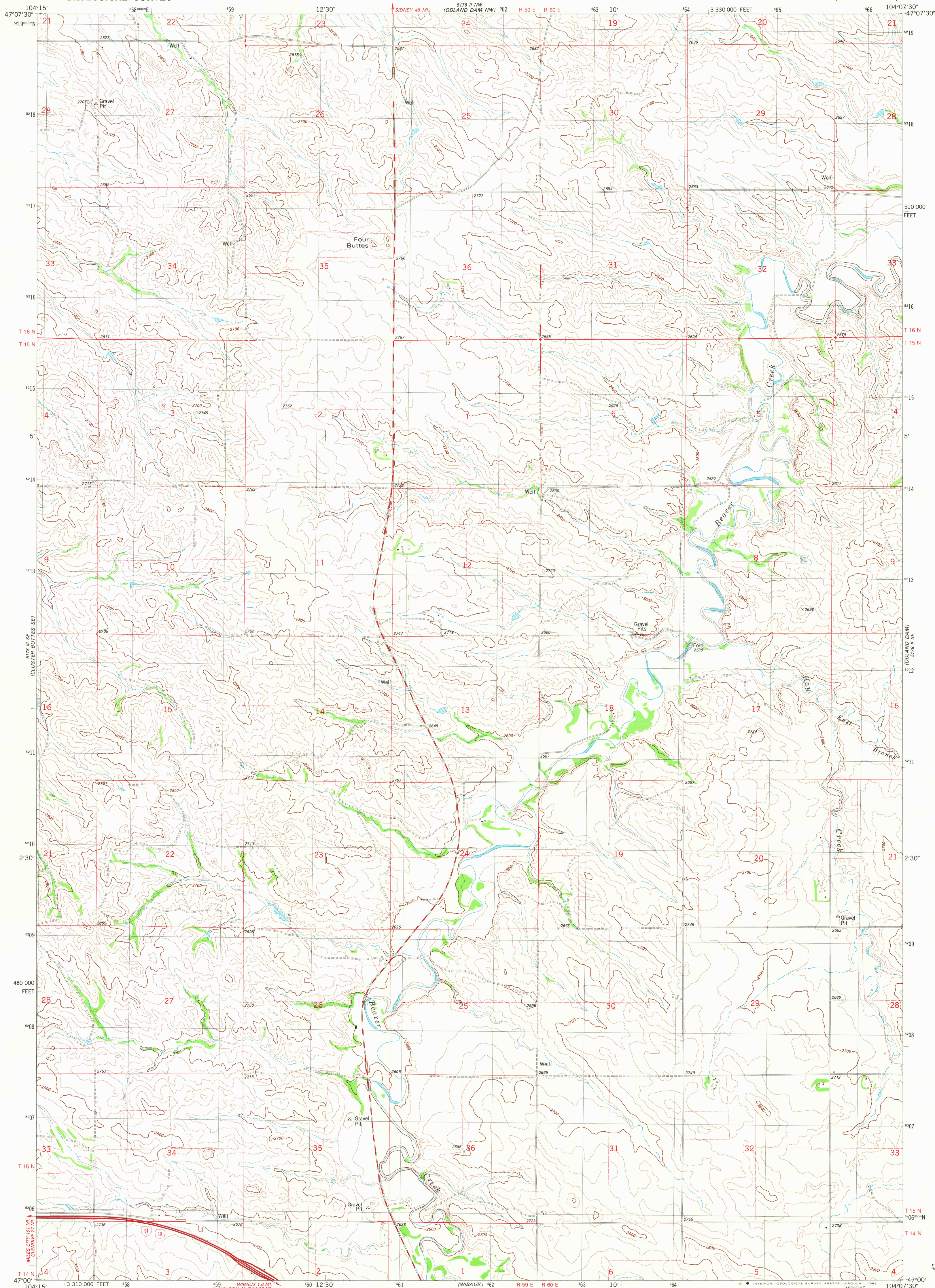

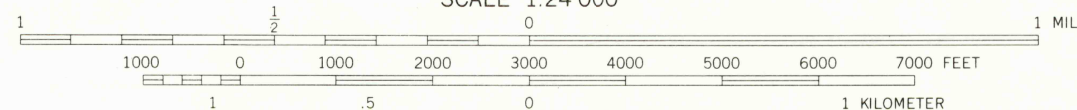
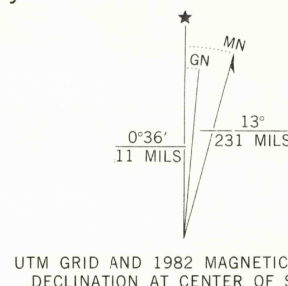

Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Montana coordinate system, central zone (Lambert conformal conic) 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 13

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 4 meters north and 40 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
