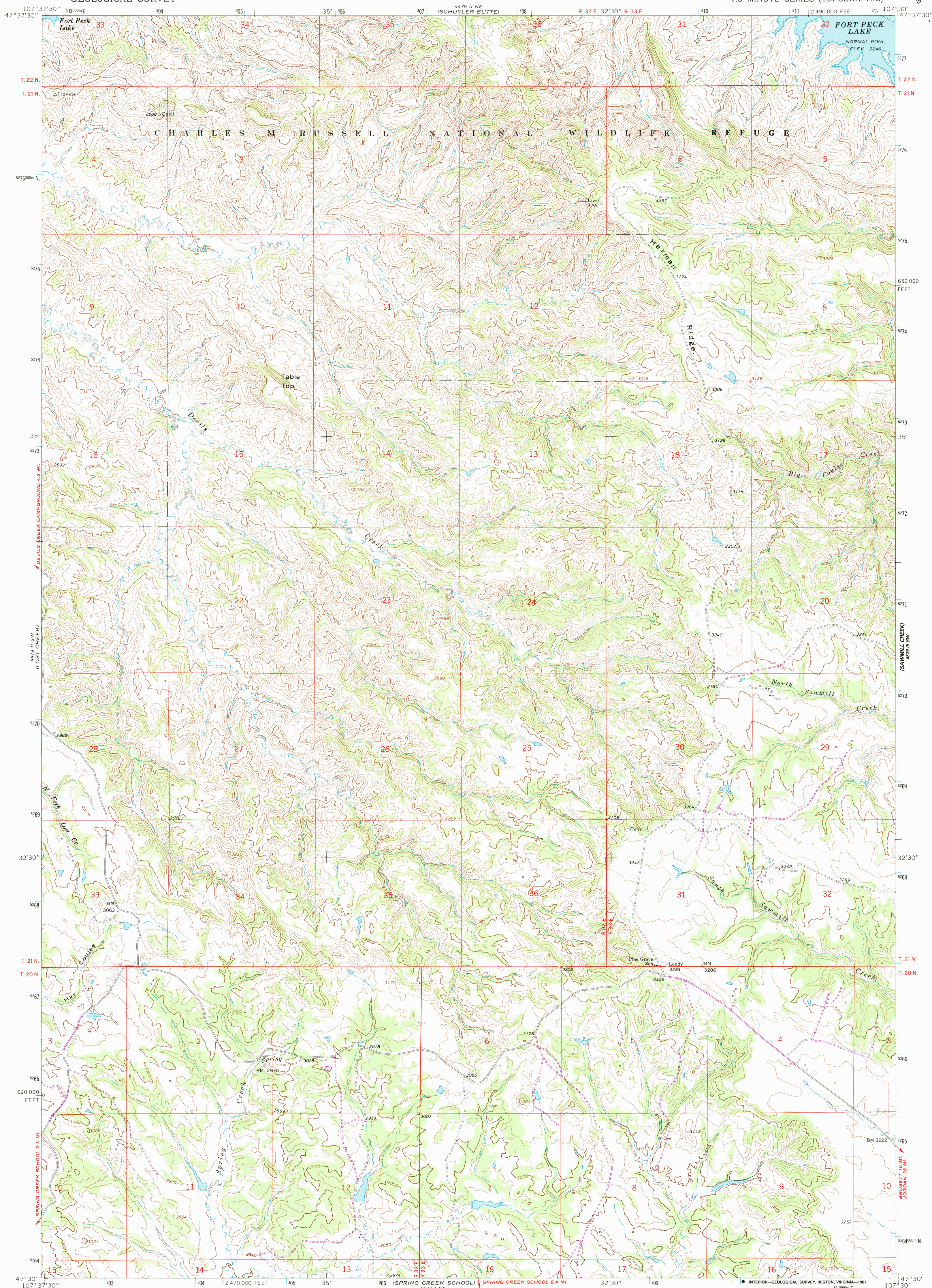


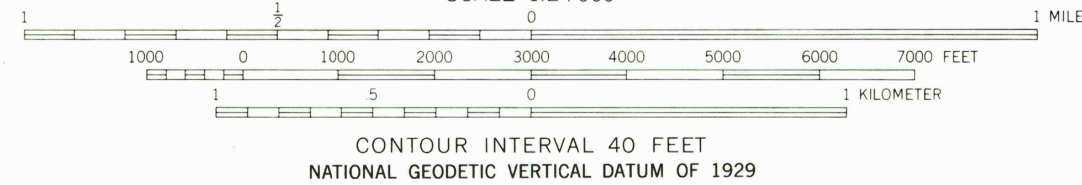
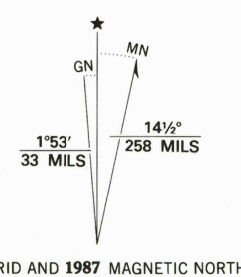

Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1964. Field checked 1965. Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Montana coordinate system, central zone. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 5 meters north and 51 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.

Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation
