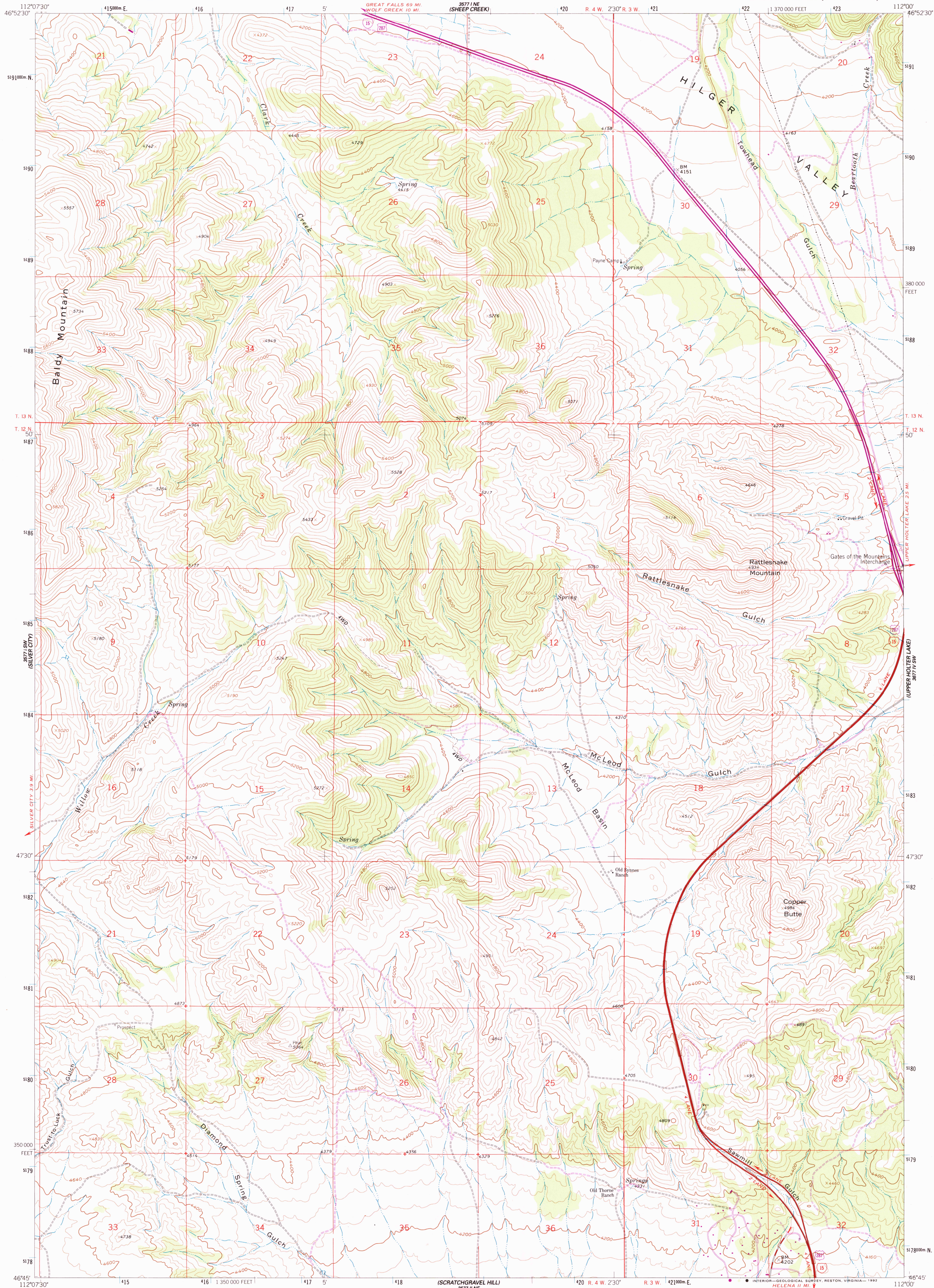

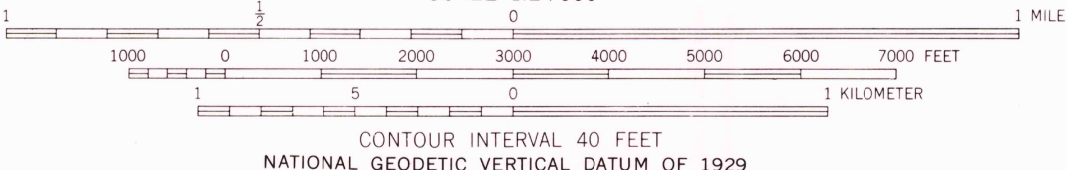
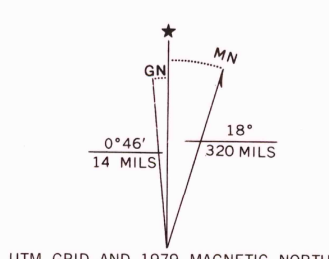

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American Datum 10,000-foot grid based on Montana coordinate system, central zone. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 12, shown in blue. The difference between 1927 North American Datum and North American Datum of 1983 (NAD 83) for 7.5 minute intersections is given in USGS Bulletin 1875. The NAD 83 is shown by dashed corner ticks.
