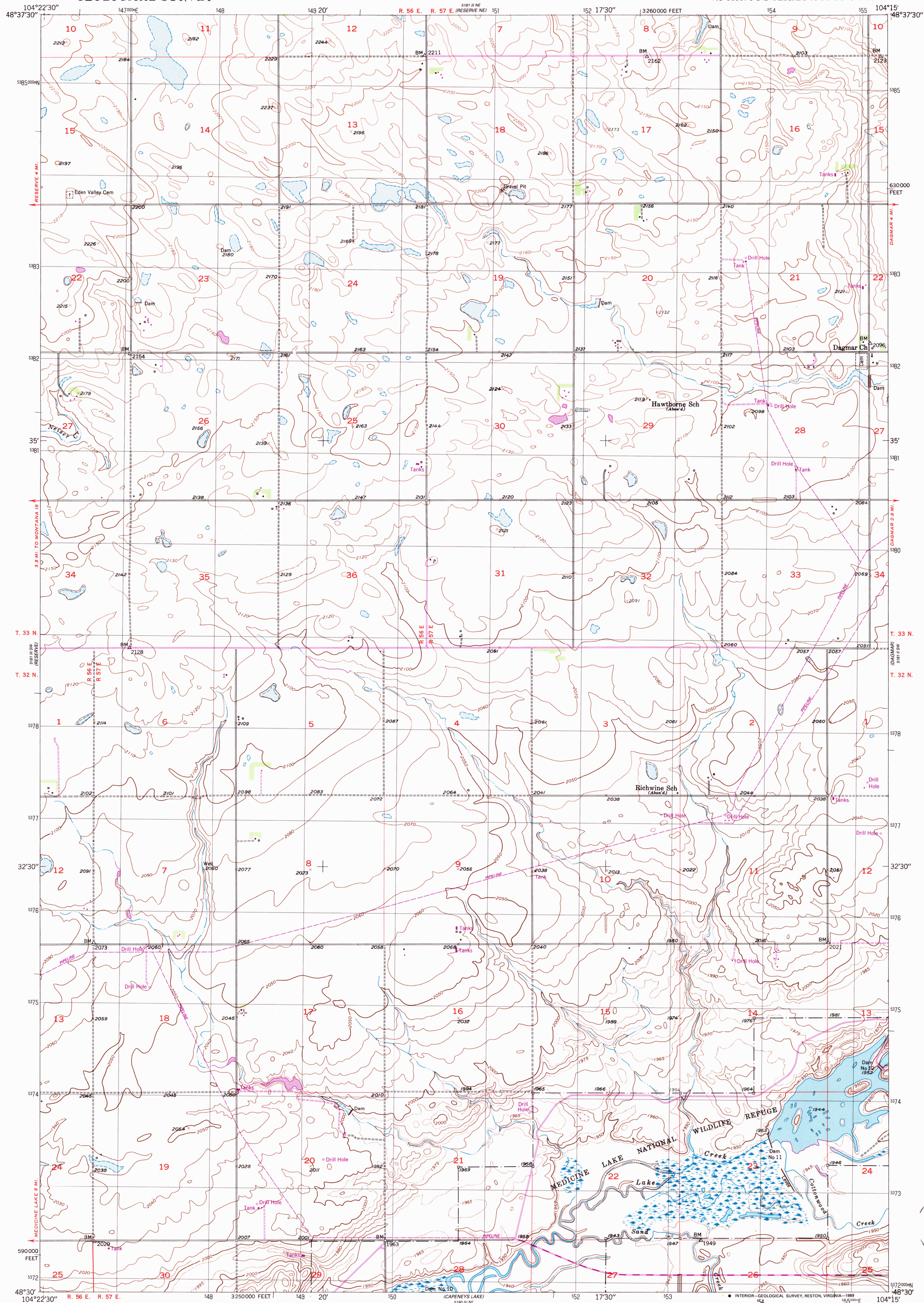

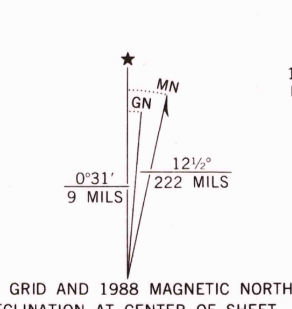
Topography by planetable methods 1946-1948
