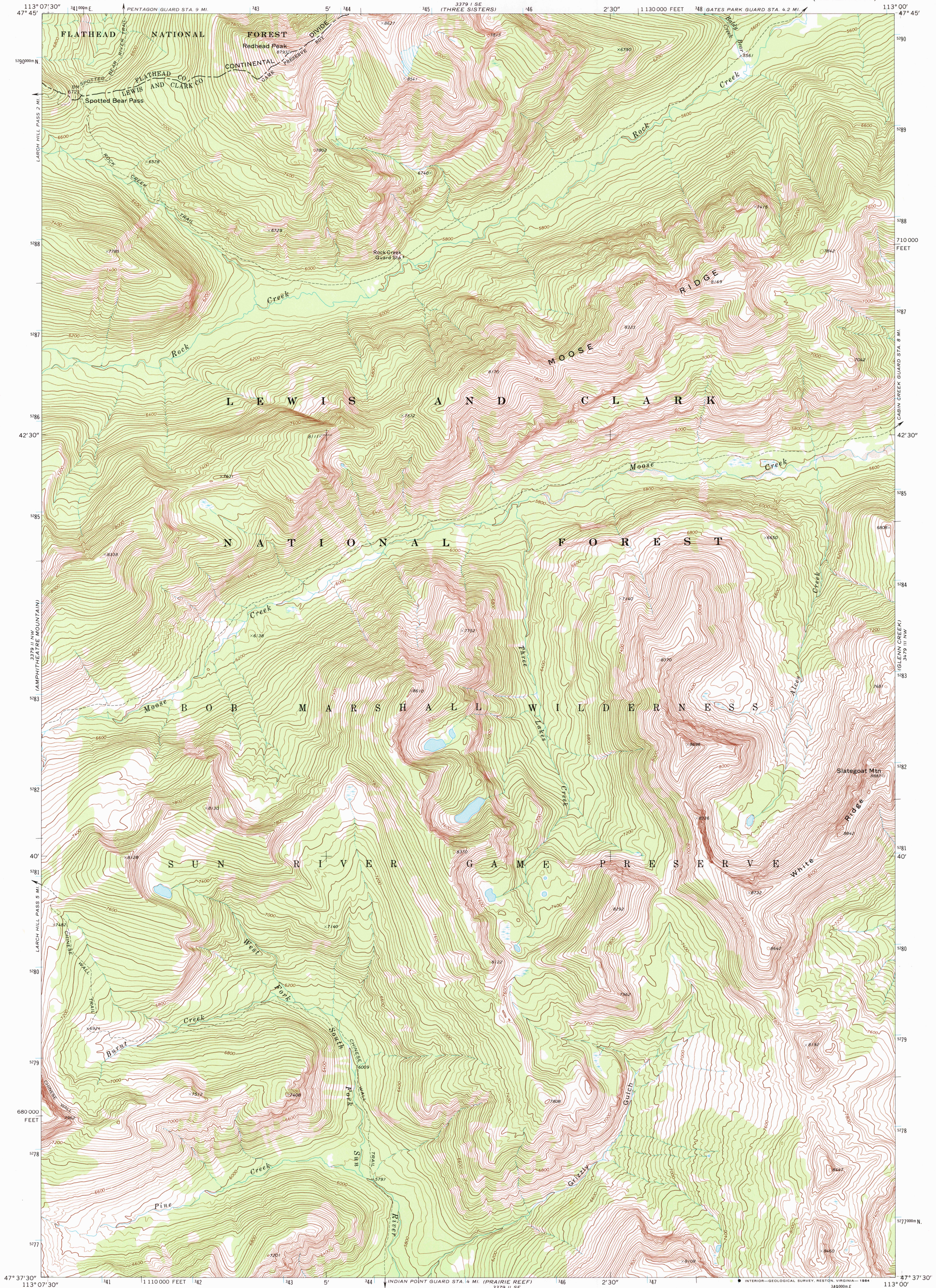

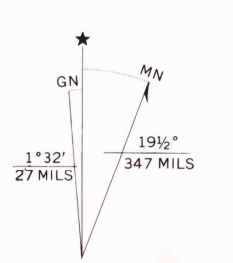

Land lines have not been established in this area

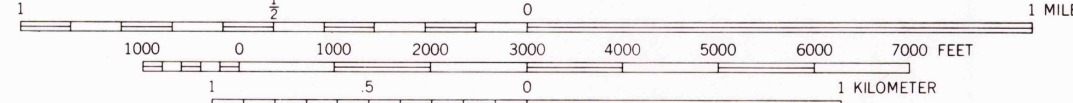
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983
