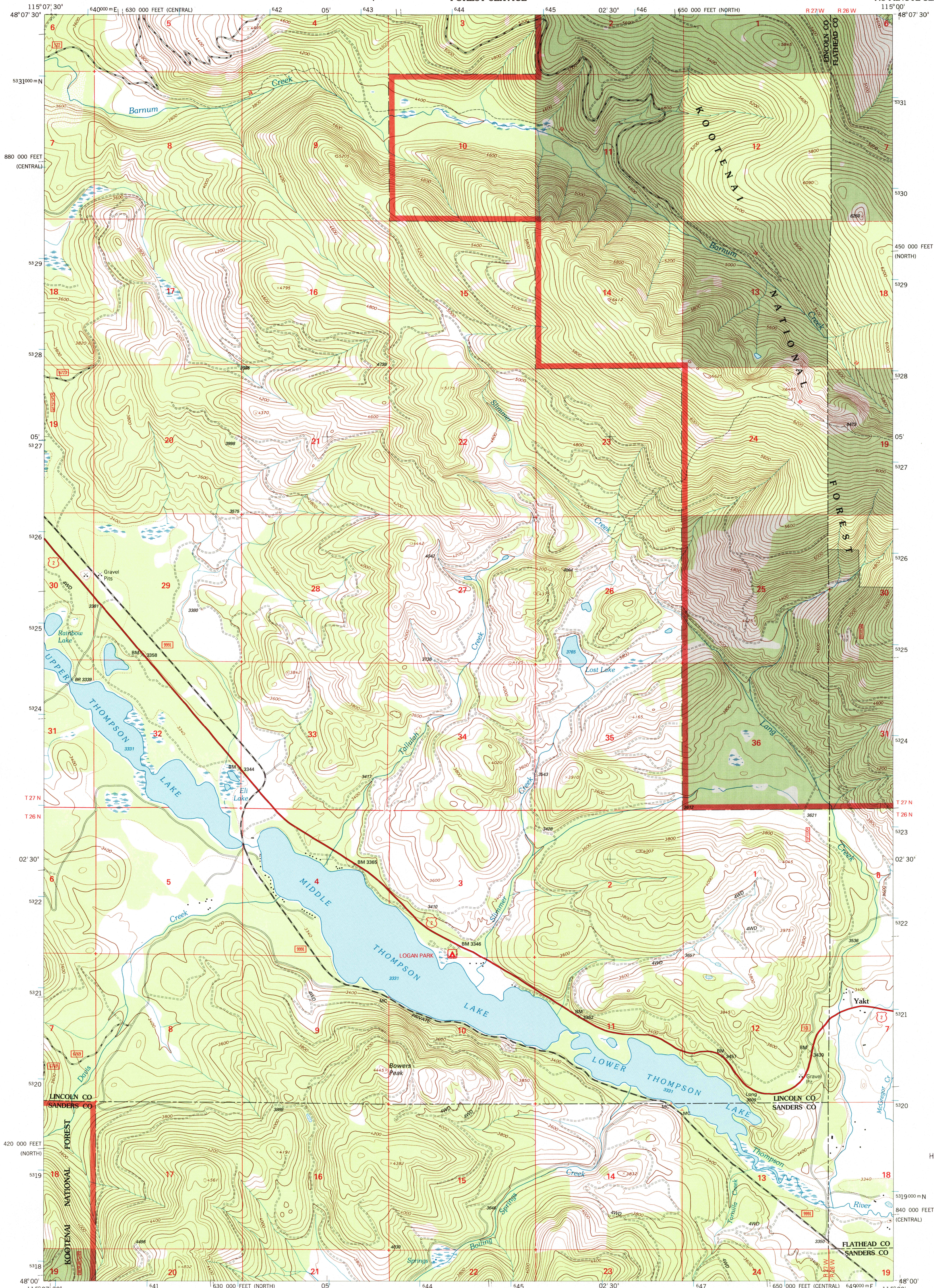

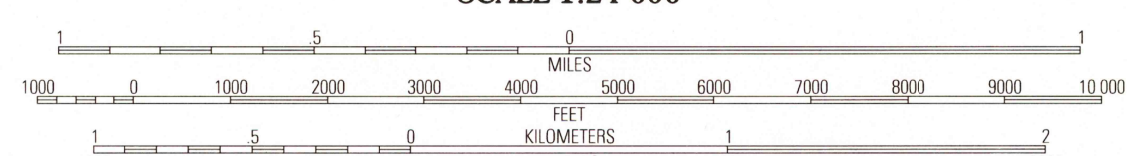
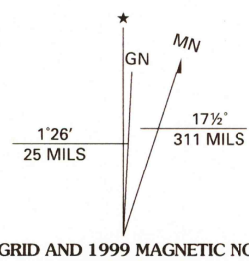

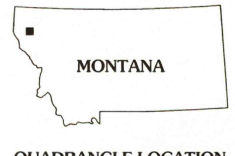
North American Datum of 1983 (NAD 83) is shown by dashed corner ticks.
