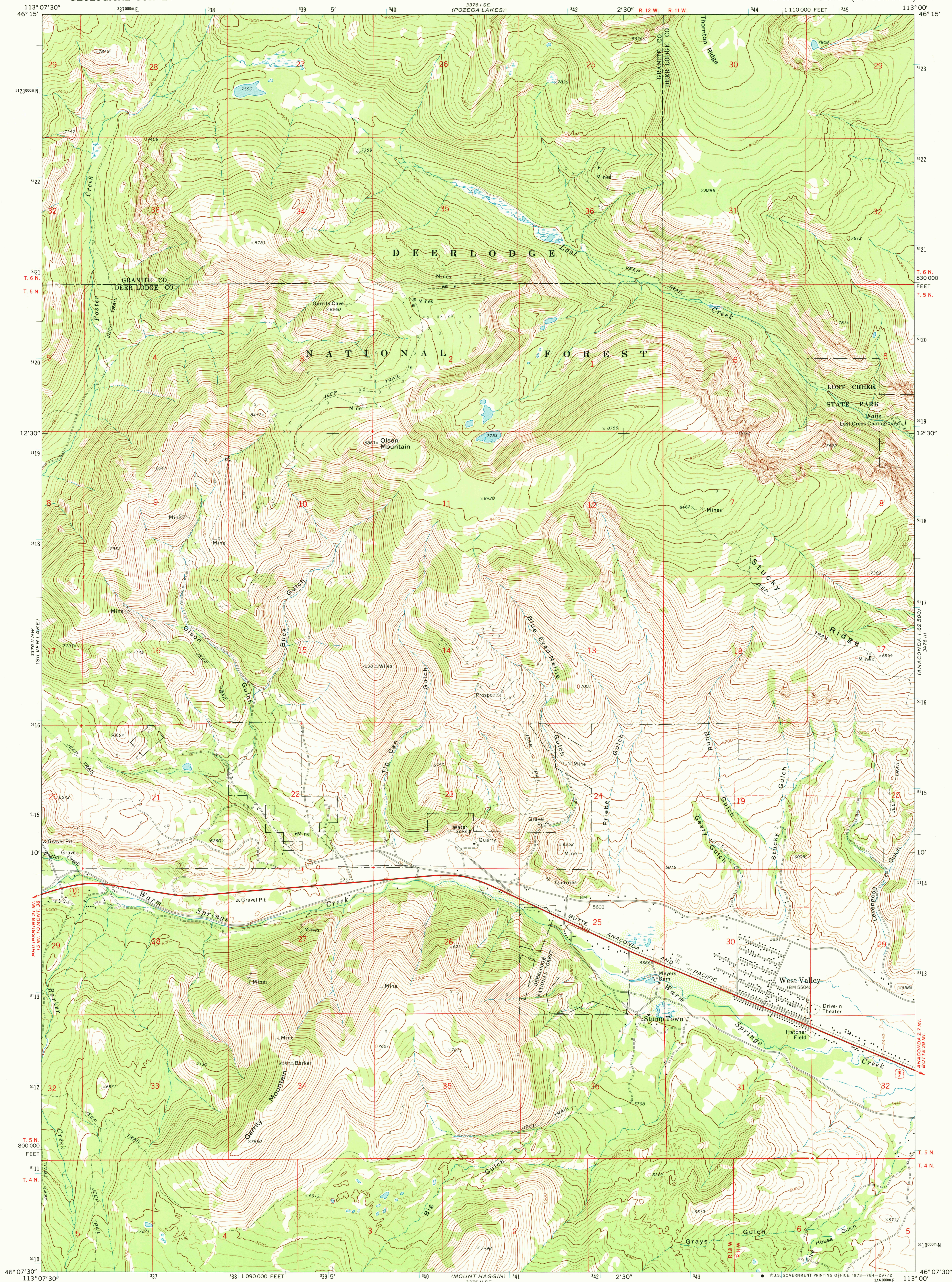
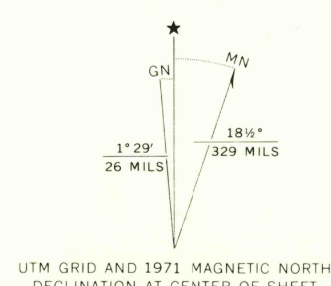

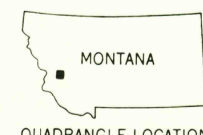
WEST VALLEY QUADRANGLE
