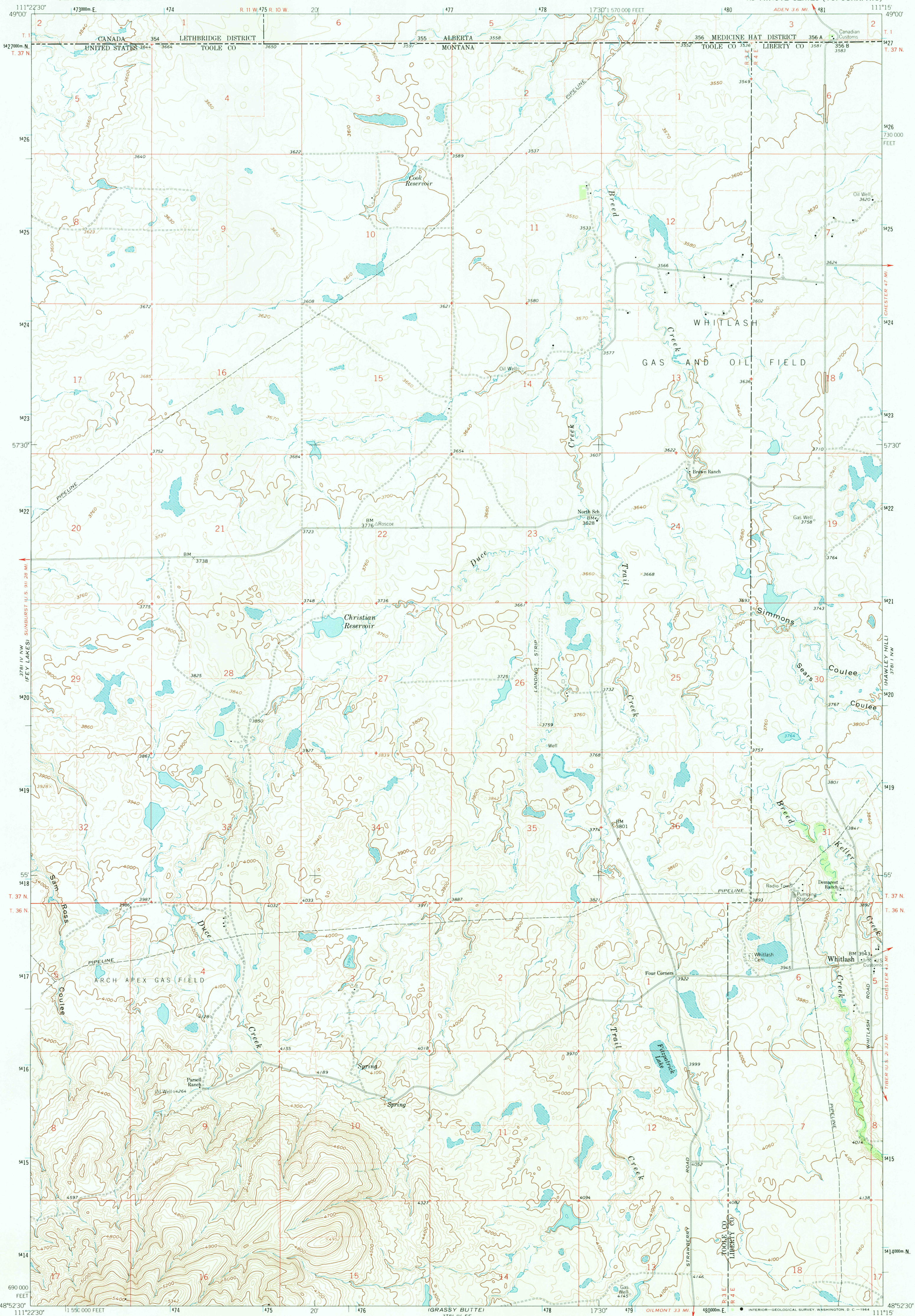

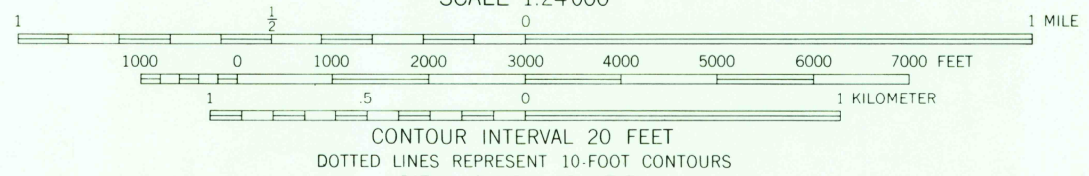
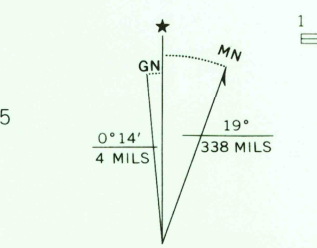
10,000-foot grid based on Montana coordinate system, north zone
