

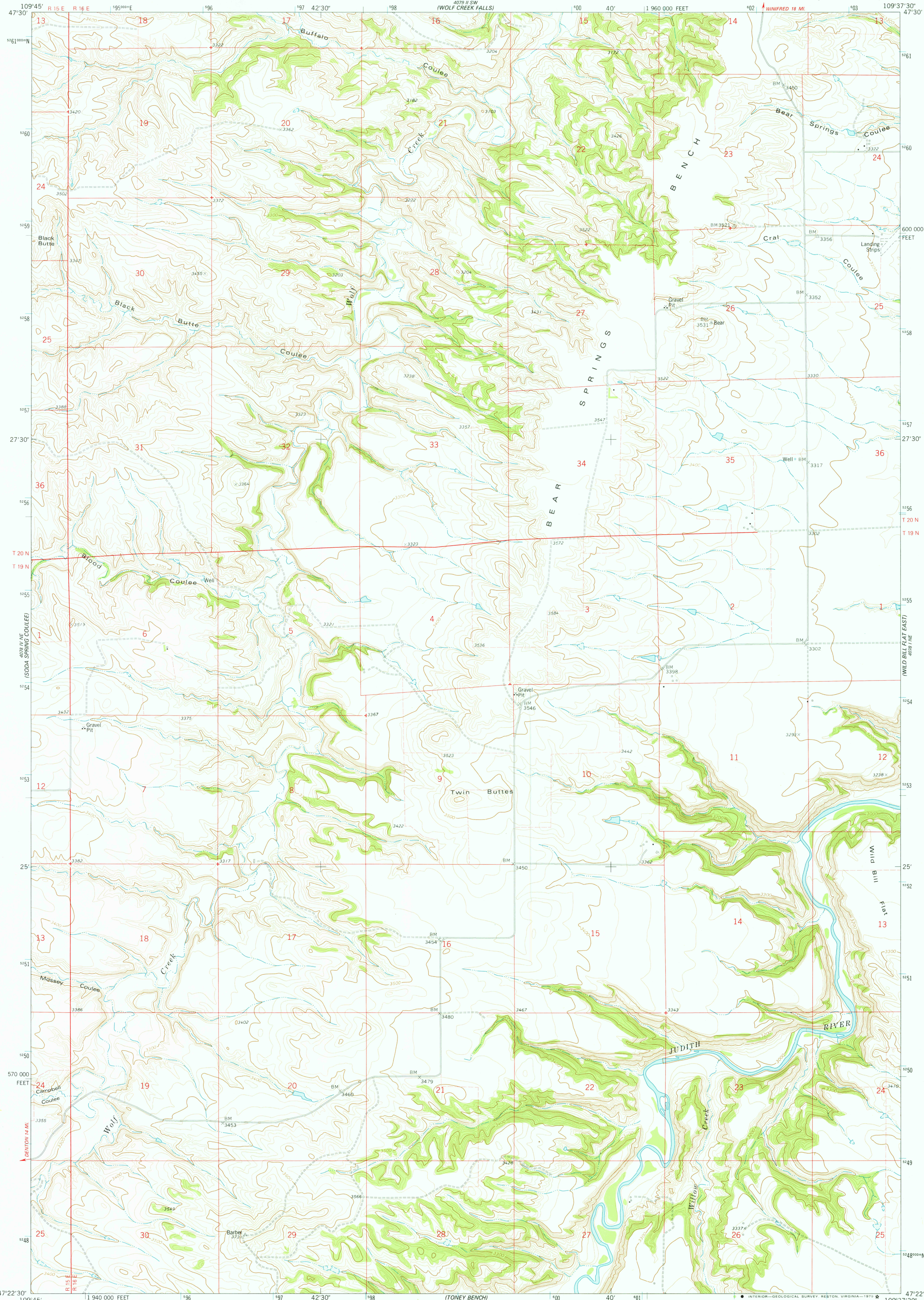

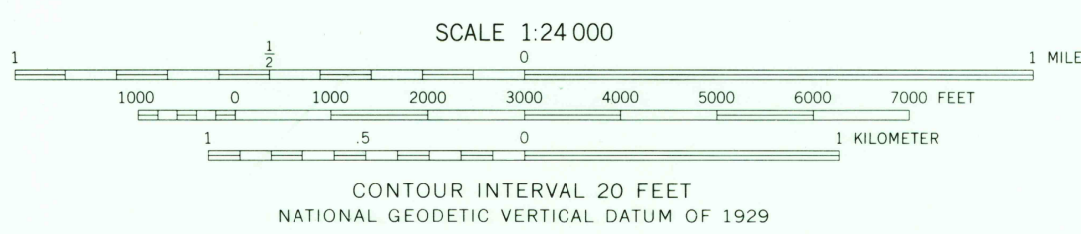
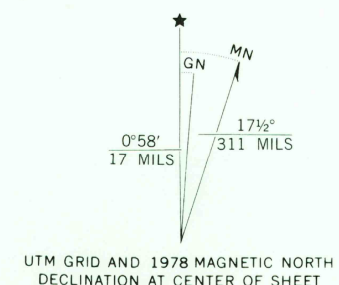


WILD BILL FLAT WEST QUADRANGLE
