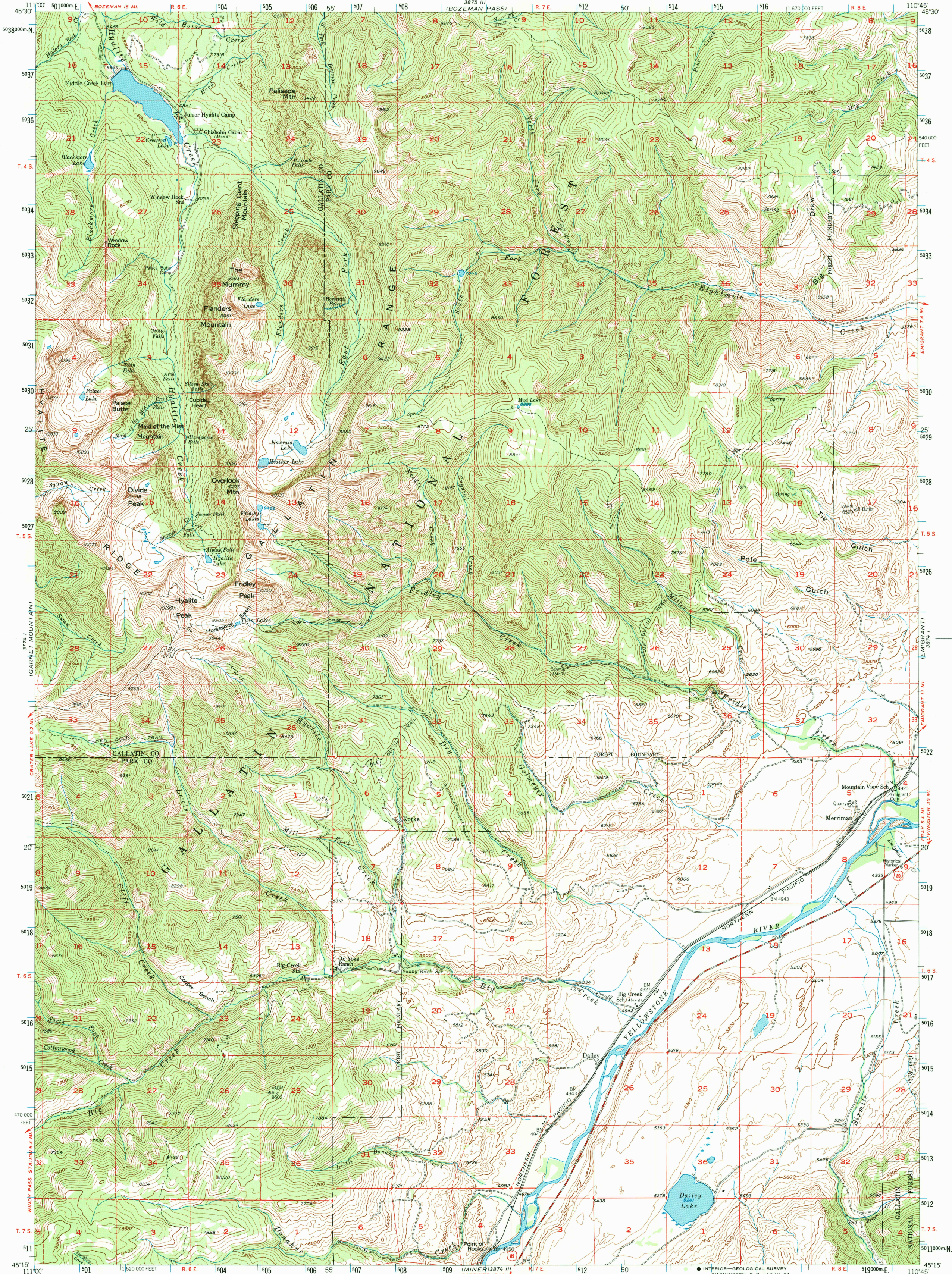
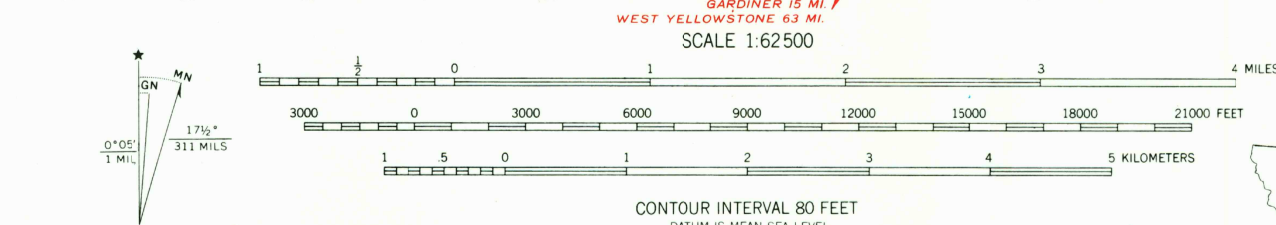

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grid based on Montana coordinate system, south zone. Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations. Certain land lines are omitted in T. 6 S., R. 7 E., because of insufficient data. Unchecked elevations are shown in brown. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 12, shown in blue.
