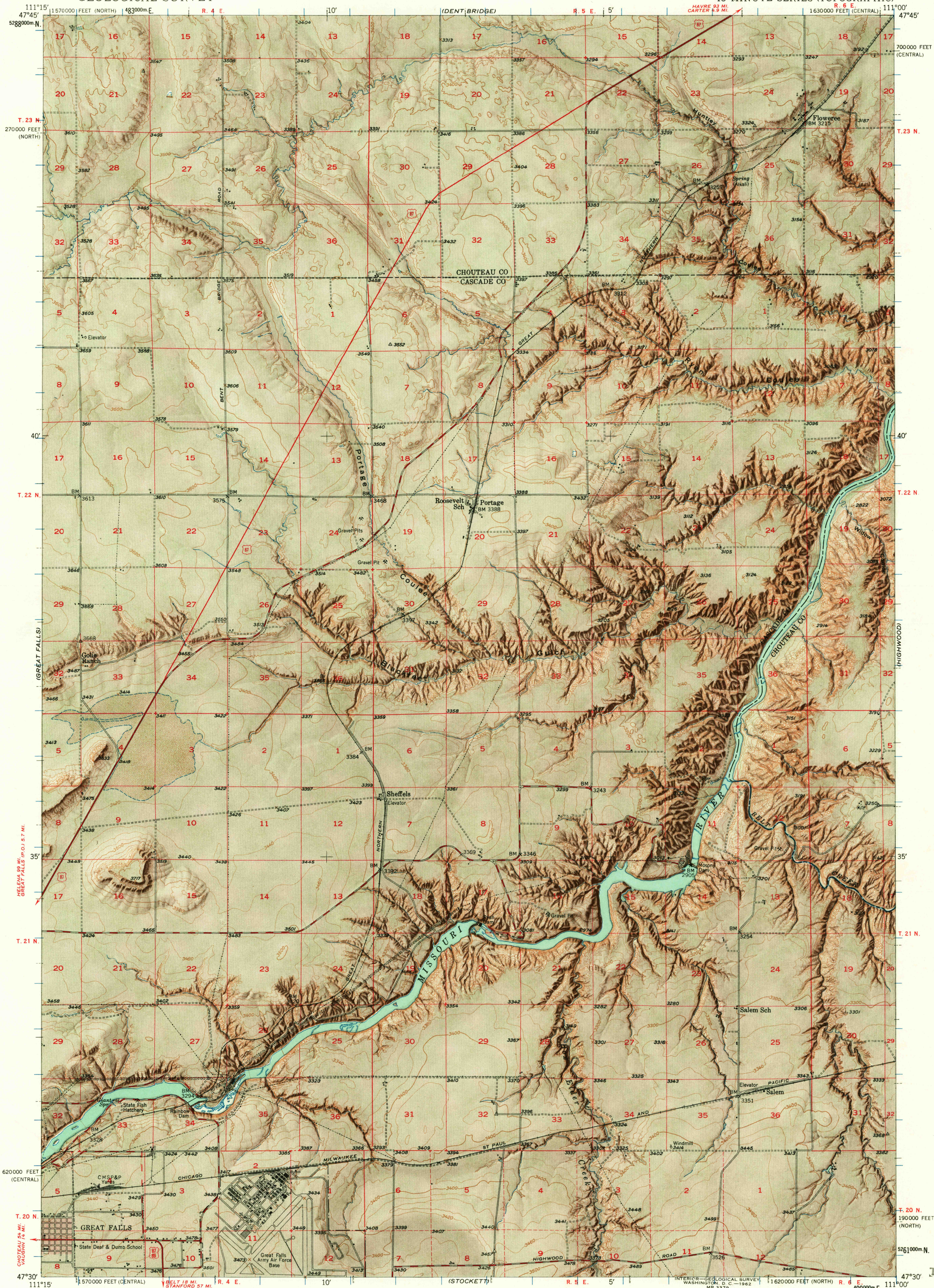

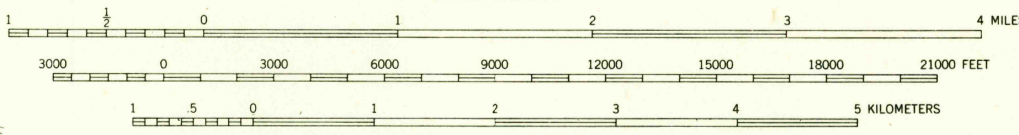

central zone and north zone

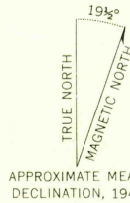
Dashed land lines indicate approximate location
