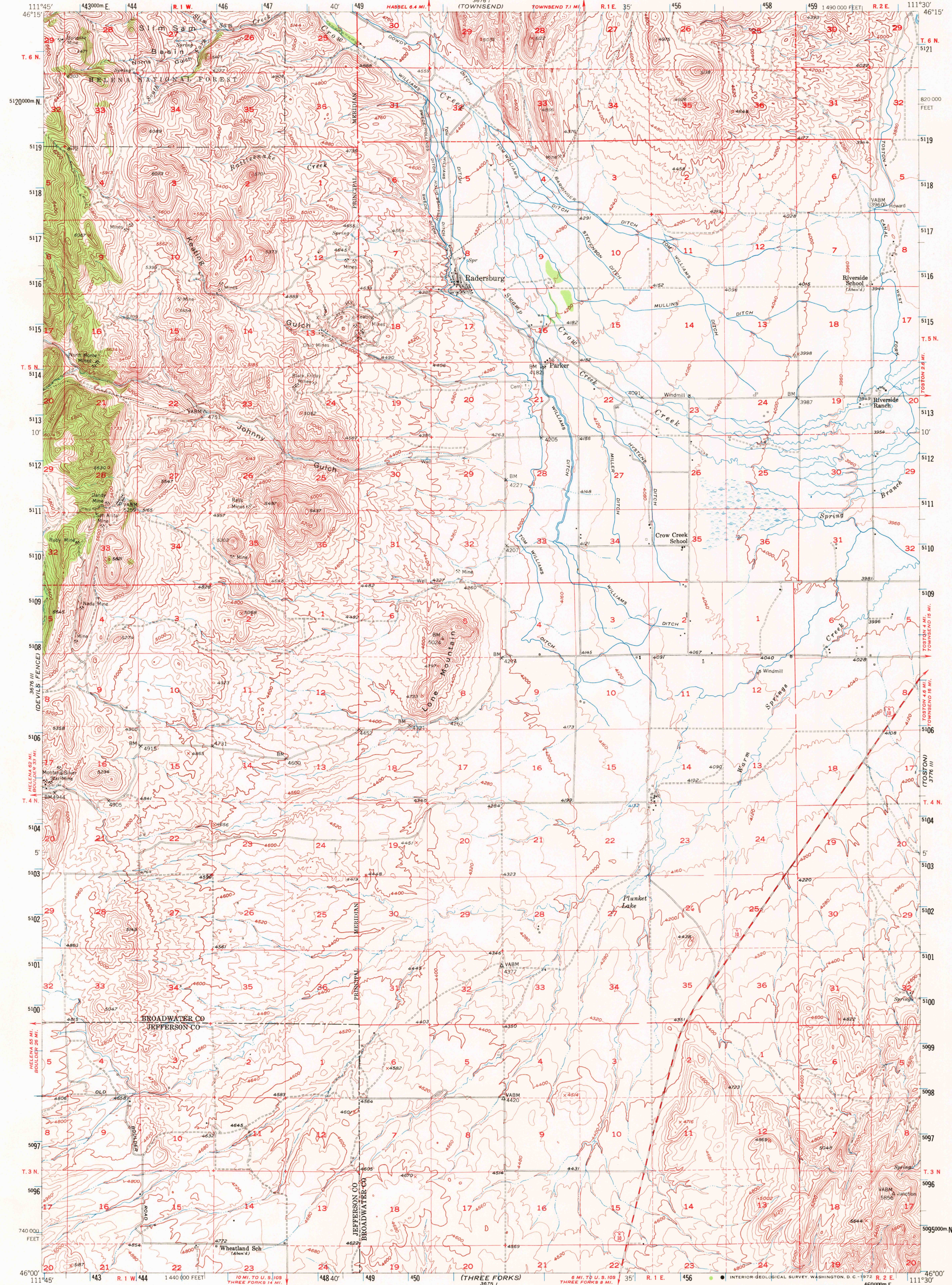

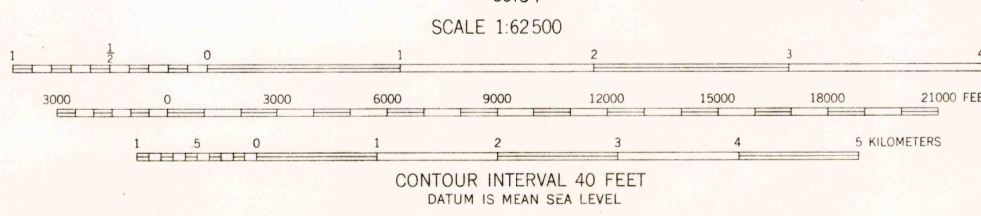
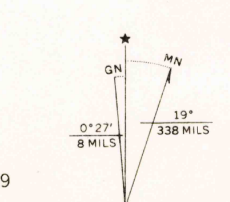
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grid based on Montana coordinate system, south zone.
