Polyconic projection. 1927 North American Datum 10,000-foot grid based on Montana coordinate system, south zone.

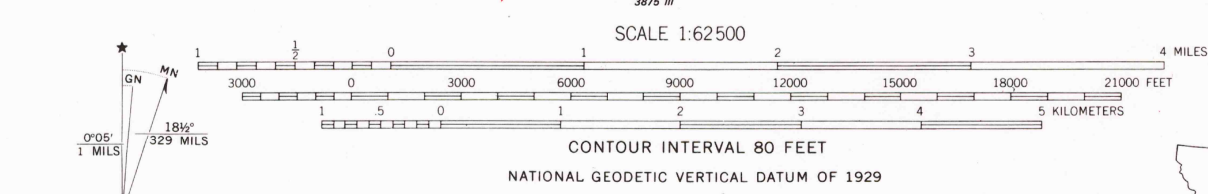
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 12, shown in blue.
