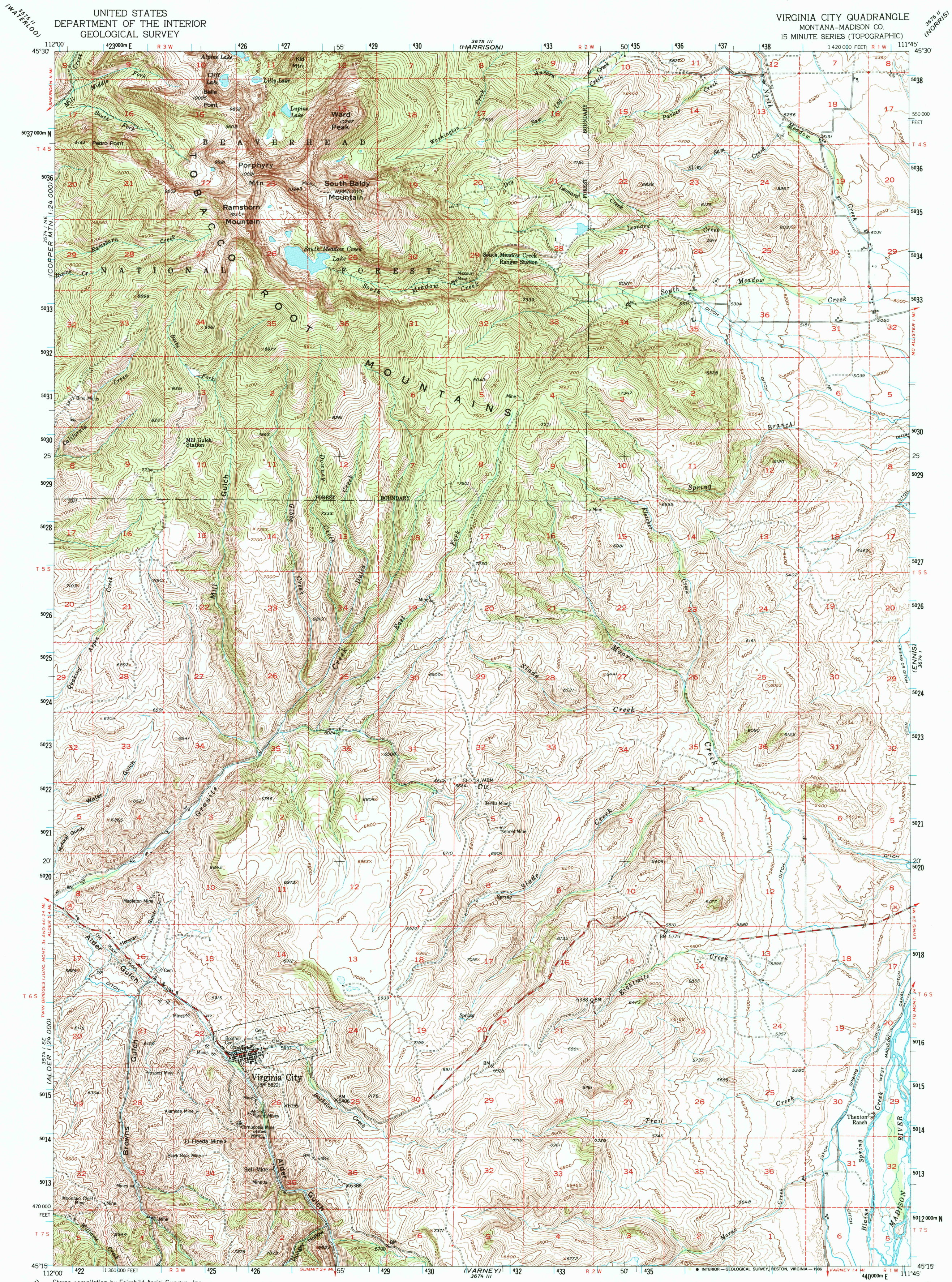

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 11 meters north and 65 meters east.
