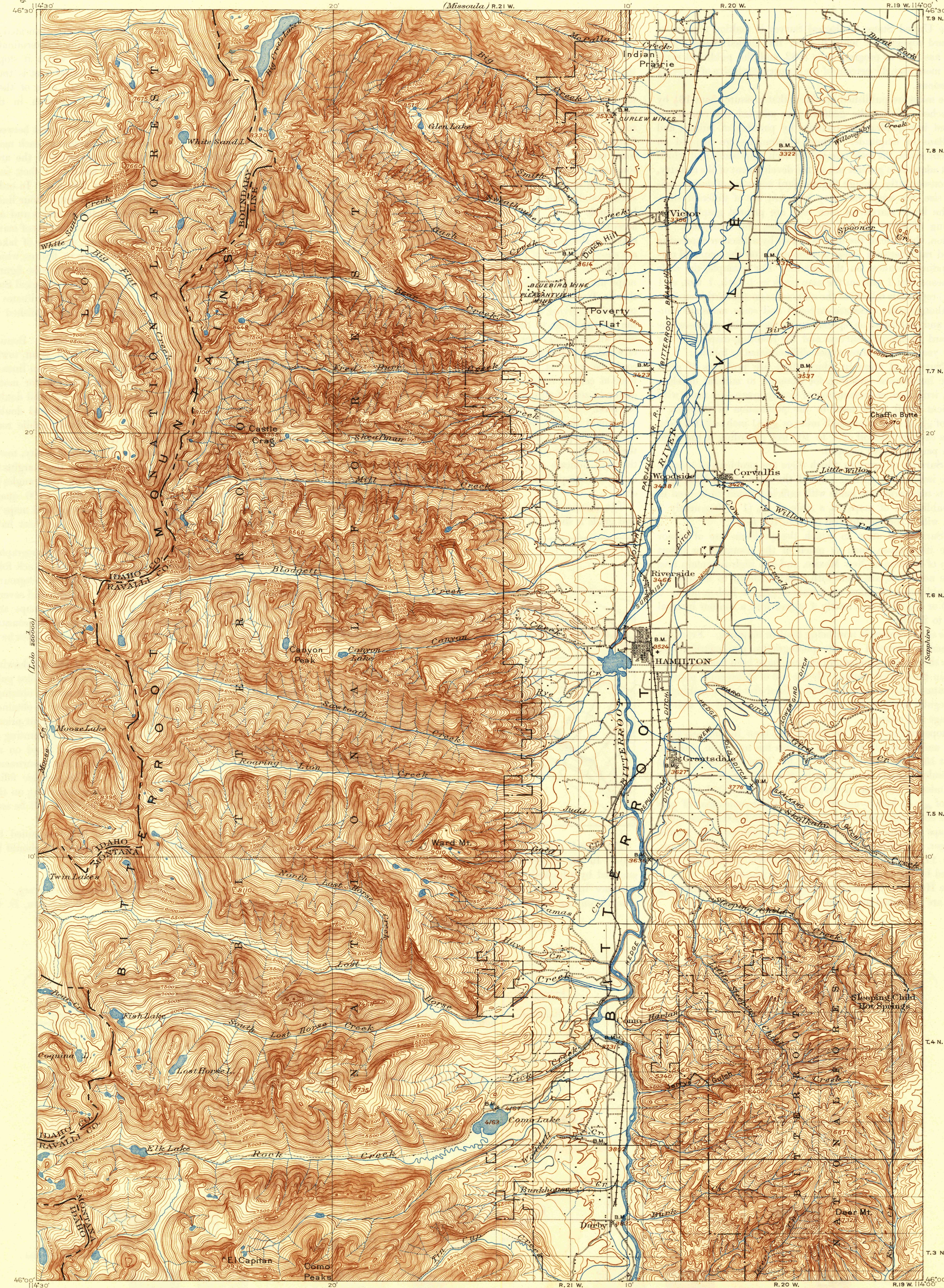




U.S. Gode, Geographer in charge.
