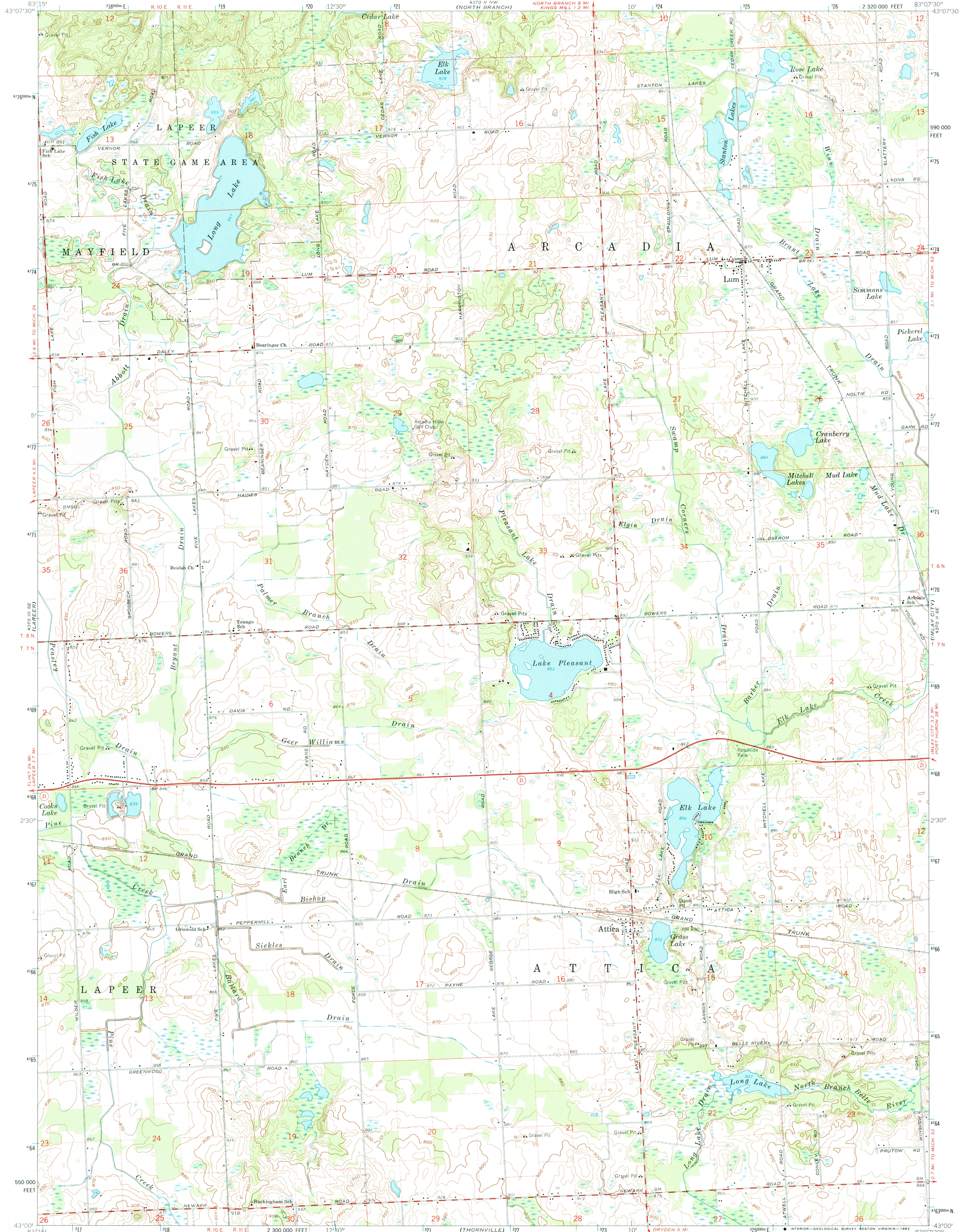




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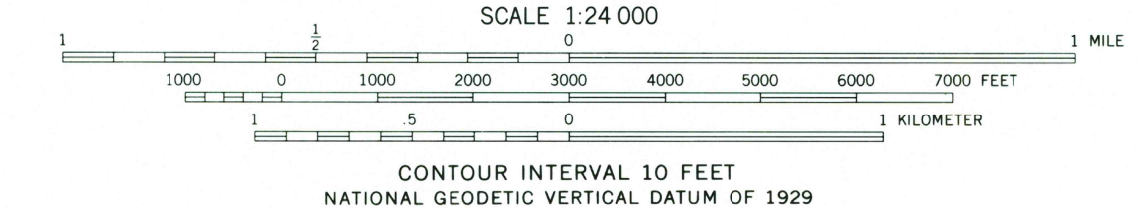
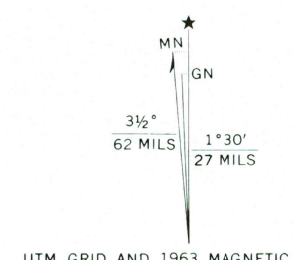
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial

zone 17, shown in blue

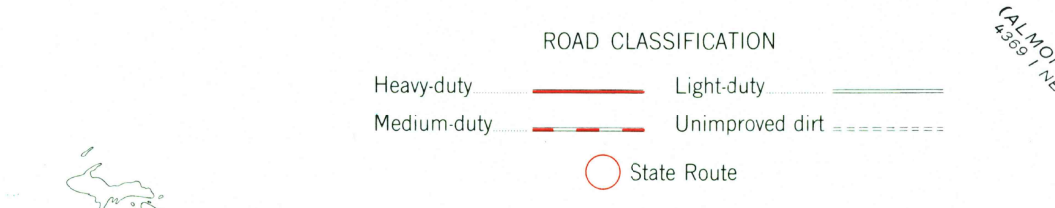
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983
