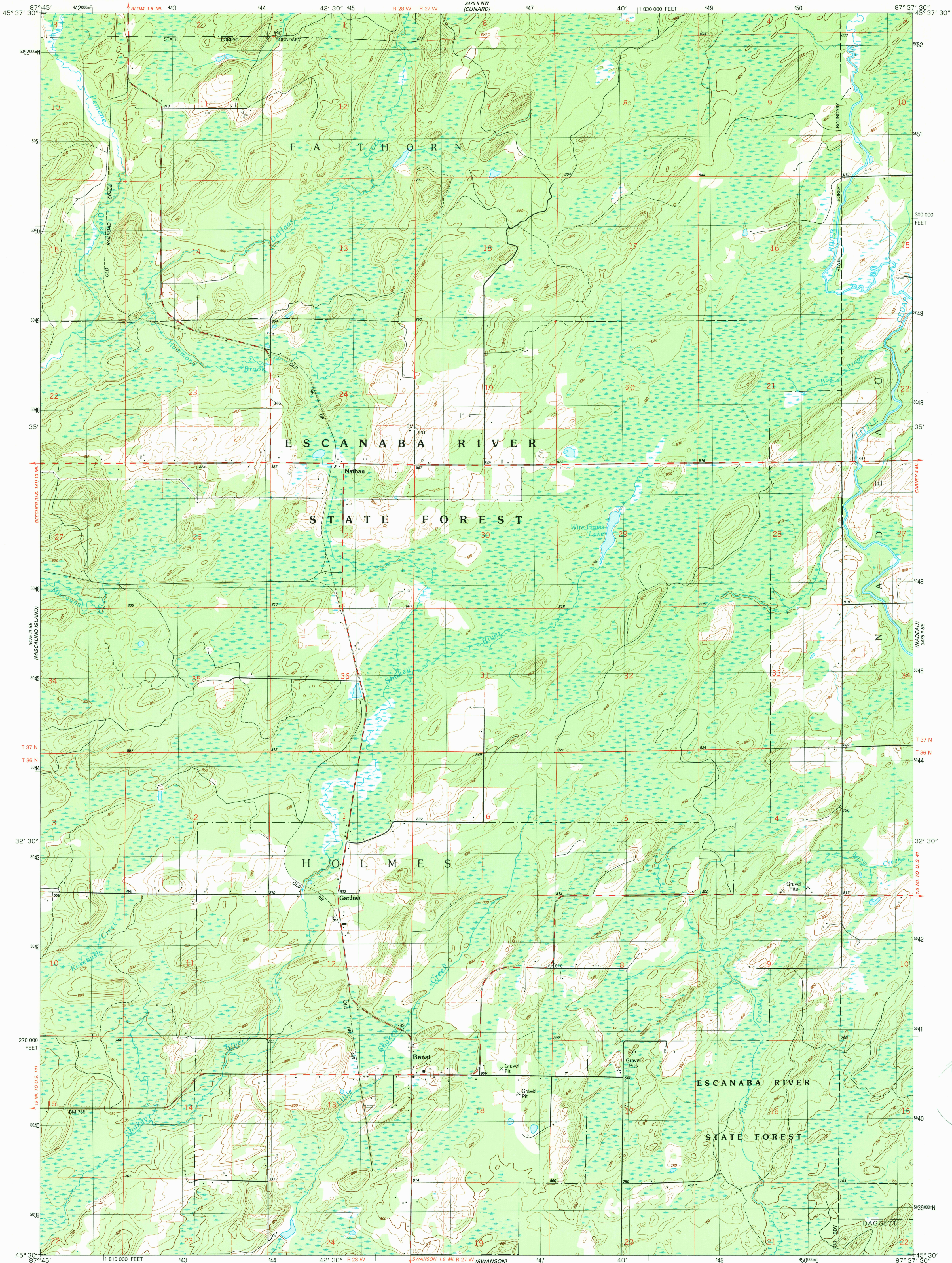

Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Michigan coordinate system, north zone (Lambert conformal conic)

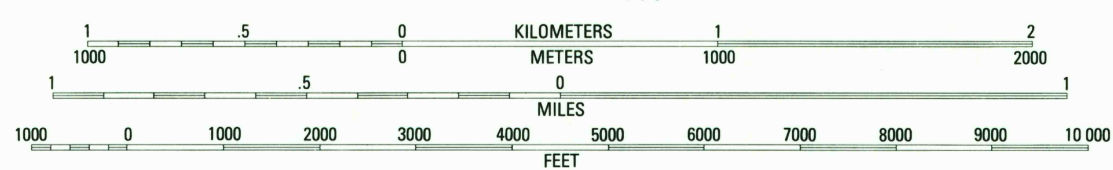
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 16 1927 North American Datum
